**PURCHASING:** Low bid meeting specifications of four bids received.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide two 15kV metal-clad, arc-resistant type 2 switchgear. The specification required 3-phase, 4-wire, 12,470 volt wye, solidly grounded neutral arc-resistant switchgear, circuit breakers and bus duct, including all control protection wiring necessary. The switchgear will be installed in a weatherproof control room at the Pedernales Substation. The existing switchgear have been in use for 45 and 43 years. This type of switchgear is the means by which power is distributed to the customer. Most Austin Energy substations operate at either 69kV or 138kV and contain transformers to lower the voltage to 15kV. The switchgear has circuit breakers which allow Austin Energy crews to connect three distinct circuits to feed neighborhoods and businesses.
