AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$197,370 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Vehicle Acquisition Fund. Funding in the amount of \$58,896 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Operating Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding in the amount of \$827,569 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budget of Austin Energy. Funding in the amount of \$215,761 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility. Funding in the amount of \$174,065 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Public Works Department. Funding in the amount of \$168,998 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Solid Waste Services Department. Funding in the amount of \$71,378 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Watershed Protection Development and Review Department.

This RCA requests approval of three contracts for the purchase of two new, and 18 replacement heavy trucks with mounted truck bodies. The trucks will be distributed between Austin Energy (AE), Aviation Department (ABIA), Austin Water Utility (AWU), Parks and Recreation Department (PARD), Public Works Department (PW), Solid Waste Services Department (SWS), Watershed Protection Development and Review Department (WPDRD).

- Truck Tractor (AWU, SWS), 1-Replacement, 1-New 2
- 4 Truck Chassis with Mounted 12 Cubic Yard Dump Body (AWU, PW, WRDRD), 3-Replacement, 1-New
- Truck Chassis with Mounted Water Tank Body (PARD), Replacement 1
- Truck Chassis with Mounted Knuckleboom Loader & 22' Dump Body (PARD), Replacement 1
- Truck Chassis with Mounted 10 Cubic Yard Concrete Mixer Body (PW), Replacement 1
- Truck Chassis with Mounted Knuckleboom loader & 12' Platform Body (SWS), Replacement The contracts include the purchase of 20 heavy trucks for a total dollar amount of \$1,714,037.

The trucks in this RCA have been recommended for purchase utilizing a process that involves the Fleet Officer, affected Department Director, and Assistant City Manager (ACM). ACM approval is required for all new additions to the City's fleet prior to any requests being made to the Purchasing Office. Departments review the list of vehicles determined eligible for replacement by Fleet Services based on mileage, hours of use, and maintenance costs. From that list, priority uses are determined within the departments and the departments' proposed equipment is reviewed by the Fleet Service Center Manager to insure the specified vehicle is appropriate for the use.

Of the 18 replacements, all have met the Fleet Officer's eligibility criteria for replacement. The Service Center Managers have inspected each piece of equipment to be replaced and determined that the mileage or hours of use of each truck proposed for replacement cannot be increased without risking a significant increase in repair costs and loss of productivity due to down time.

An additional truck tractor is for Solid Waste Services and will be used to pull trailers used in processing recyclable paper. An additional 12 cubic yard dump truck for Watershed Protection Development Review Department will be used by the storm drain rehabilitation construction crews to haul materials to repair storm drain lines.

There are currently no manufacturers supplying gasoline engines for these size trucks chassis. The trucks are powered by diesel engines that meet the federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) guidelines for emissions. To legally sell the engines, the engine manufacturers must meet the incremental requirements established by the EPA for each model year. The City is buying diesel with the lowest sulfur content available on the market. There are no alternative fuel options for the application.

Equipment Technology, truck body dealer, submitted a bid that could not be considered for award. Texas Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Licensing Division does not permit the sale of a new truck chassis in Texas unless it is sold by a Texas franchise vehicle dealer.
