SUBJECT: Approve an ordinance amending Section 12-4-63 of the City Code to delete Jollyville Road from 100 feet south of Adolph Alley to 450 feet north of Mesa Drive from the list of streets having a maximum speed limit of 20 miles per hour in a school zone based on the closure of Grace Covenant Christian School.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$2,900 is available the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Operating Budget of the Public Works Department for the removal of signs and flashers.

Due to the closure of Grace Covenant Christian School at the end of May 2005, the Transportation Division of the Public Works Department is recommending the removal of the existing 20 mph reduced speed school zone on Jollyville Road. The speed limit for the street segment will return to 35 miles per hour.

Amendment to Code Section 12-4-63 (20 MPH School Zone):

Remove: Jollyville Road from 100 feet south of Adolph alley to 450 feet north of Mesa Drive (Grace Covenant Christian School).

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-63 OF THE CITY CODE TO DELETE A PORTION OF JOLLYVILLE ROAD FROM THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MILES PER HOUR IN A SCHOOL ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-63 (*20 Mile Per Hour School Zones*) of the City Code is amended to delete:

Jollyville Road from 100 feet south of Adolph Alley to 450 feet north of Mesa Drive (Grace Covenant Christian School).

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

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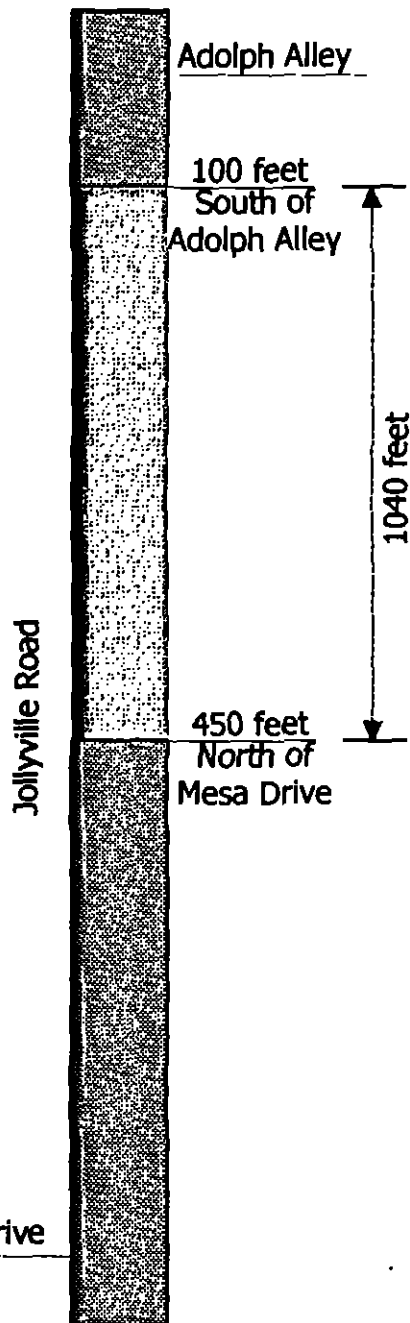
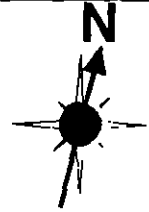
