<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of a construction contract with BARECKY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, Wimberley, TX, for Spicewood Springs Branch Library Expansion Re-Bid in the amount of \$1,544,640 plus a \$108,124.80 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,652,764.80.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: The resolution authorizing the filing of eminent domain proceedings to acquire the fee simple interest in Lot 5, Town and Country Village Addition, Section 4, Phase 1, Williamson County Texas, owned by Nieman Properties, for the Spicewood Springs Branch Library Expansion, approved November 4, 1999; resolution awarding the construction contract for Spicewood Springs Branch Library Site Work Improvements September 9, 2004.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: Conditional Use Permit approved by Zoning and Platting Commission.

PURCHASING: Lowest bid of four received.

MBE / WBE: 8.00 % MBE and 25.52 % WBE subcontractor participation.

The work under this contract provides for a 4,769 square foot addition to the Spicewood Springs Branch Library, interior renovations, and a new HVAC system to the existing 8,488 square foot library. Included will be new landscaping and irrigation system. Major site improvements, including increased number of parking spaces, realignment of an existing driveway and a detention pond were completed in January 2005 under a separate contract.

The Library Department has elected to accept all 8 additive alternates included in the bid: Book Drop Canopy, Mechanically Seamed Roof System, New Gutters and Downspouts; Site Clean-up within Specific Areas; Pruning of Existing Trees; Pruning of Large Specimen Trees; Parking Lot Sealing and Restriping, and Masonry Cleaning.

Due to the potential for unknown conditions when doing a major building addition, a 7% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 240 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 10 general contractors. Bids were opened on July 27, 2005. Barecky Construction Company submitted the lowest of 4 bids received:


