SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a construction contract with CAPITAL EXCAVATION COMPANY, (84.17%), Austin, TX, for the Austin Clean Water Program: Lower South Boggy Creek Phase III - Wales Way Wastewater Improvements Project in an amount not to exceed \$264,234.

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Lowest bid of five received.

MBE / WBE: 0.00% MBE and 2.14% WBE subcontractor participation.

This construction contract will provide for wastewater improvements within a mostly residential area southwest of Austin near Dittmar Park on the Lower South Boggy Creek. The wastewater line being installed is from 732 to 748 Wales Way beginning at Dulwich Street.

The improvements will replace aging and deteriorated wastewater facilities and eliminate the repeated wastewater overflows currently occurring in this area. The project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows.

This project is to construct approximately 528 linear feet of 12-inch sewer to replace the existing 12-inch pipe using open trench construction. The proposed 12-inch sewer will connect to an existing 10-inch wastewater line. There are seven known service connections on this line.

The contract allows 60 working days for completion of this project and is scheduled to begin in December 2005.

Bid documents were distributed to 11 general contractors. Bids were opened on 9/8/05. Capital Excavation Company submitted the lowest of 5 bids received:


