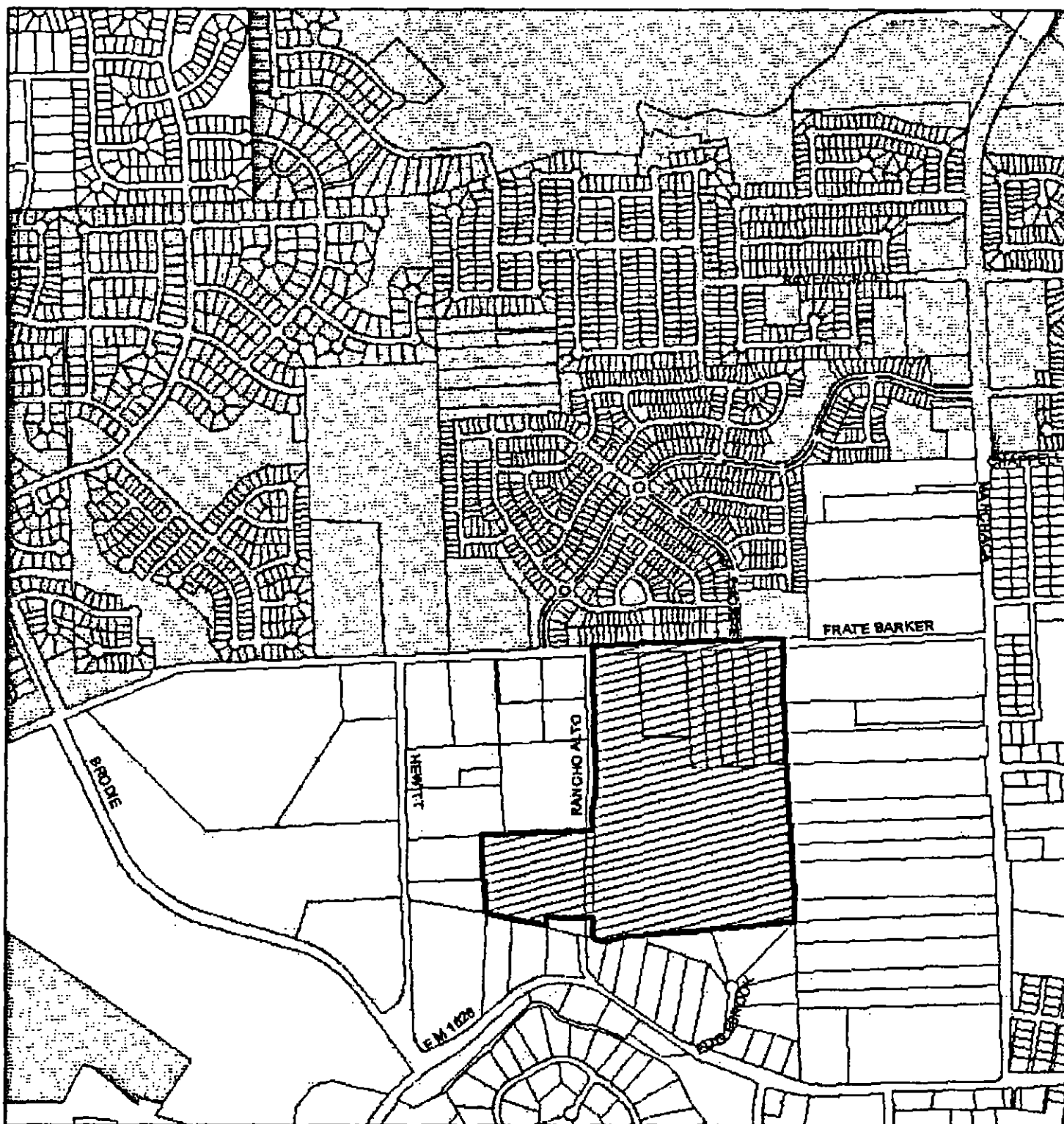




BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: N/A
