

RESOLUTION NO. 050113-16

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin, to authorize the application for \$249,961 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Coverdell Forensics Science Improvement Program for the training in forensic sample evidence examination and purchase of equipment for the Austin Police Department, Forensics Science Division for the grant period February 1, 2005 to August 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for State grant renewal funds for said project, in the amount of \$249,961 from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Coverdell Forensics Science Improvement Program for the Austin Police Department, Forensic Science Division; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for public safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the


funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; **NOW, THEREFORE,**
