

**ORDINANCE NO. 20050818-044**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3-1 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO LIVESTOCK ENCLOSURES.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Subsection 3-1-1(7) of the City Code is amended to read:

- (1) **MINIATURE LIVESTOCK** means livestock [~~weighing less than 200 pounds and standing no more than 36 inches at the withers or shoulder~~] that meet the published breed definition for registration by a nationally recognized breeding association.

**PART 2.** Section 3-2-14 is amended to read:

**§ 3-2-14      ENCLOSURE FOR LIVESTOCK.**

- (A) Except as provided in Subsection (B), an [An] enclosure used to keep livestock, other than miniature livestock, must be located:

- (1) at least 100 feet from adjoining residentially zoned property; and  
(2) at least 50 feet from a structure used for human habitation.

- (B) An enclosure used to keep not more than one livestock animal weighing less than 200 pounds must be located at least 10 feet from a structure used for human habitation, other than a structure owned or occupied by the owner or handler of the livestock.

**PART 3.** Subsection 3-2-15(A) is amended to read:

**§ 3-2-15 ENCLOSURE FOR MINIATURE LIVESTOCK.**


- (A) An enclosure used to keep one or two female or neutered male miniature livestock must be located at least 10 [~~20~~] feet from a structure used for human habitation, other than a structure owned or occupied by the owner or handler of the miniature livestock.

**PART 4.** This ordinance takes effect on August 29, 2005.




