

ORDINANCE NO. 20051006-006

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006 NEIGHBORHOOD HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 20050912-001 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes acceptance of grant funds in the amount of \$17,175,270 from the Texas Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management for FEMA Interim Housing Public Assistance for Presidential Disaster Declaration FEMA 3216 E M related to the Hurricane Katrina evacuation.


PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Neighborhood Housing and Community Development Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 20050912-001, to appropriate \$17,175,270 for costs related to assisting Hurricane Katrina evacuees traveling to and seeking shelter in the City of Austin.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.




