BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

WHEREAS, Austin has a vibrant live music scene and is often referred to as the “Live Music Capital of the World”; and

WHEREAS, one of the strengths of Austin’s live music scene is the diverse range of artists and musical styles that residents and visitors alike may experience; and

WHEREAS, Latino artists and musical styles have always been an integral part of Austin’s live music scene; and

WHEREAS, the City of Austin featured Latino artists as part of its “Live at the Plaza” music series in May 2005 in collaboration with the Austin Latino Music Association; and

WHEREAS, the City of Austin seeks to continue and to expand its support for live music in Austin and to highlight the diverse elements of its live music scene; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:


The City Council designates the month of May as Latino Music Month;
