

Regular meeting of the City Council: Austin, Texas, August 26th 1915.

The Council was called to order by Councilman Bartholomew, Mayor, pro tem:

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas :

That the action of the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Austin, Texas, and their efforts in bringing the United States troops to be moved from Texas City to the City of Austin ,be and are hereby fully concurred in and ratified by th this body .

That a copy of this resolution be furnished the Chamber of Commerce to be used by them as they see fit.
