

Regular meeting of the City Council : Austin, Texas, September 2nd 1915.

The Council was called to order by Councilman Bartholomew, Mayor Pro tem: Roll called :

By Councilman Haynes, An ordinance providing for the issuance of \$ 50,000. of bonds of the City of Austin, for the purpose of constructing and installing sanitary Sewers in said City, and providing for the levying and collection of taxes for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon.
