

Regular meeting of the City Council : Austin, Texas Dec 16th 1915.

The minutes of the last regular and subsequent recessed meetings were read and adopted :

Councilman Haynes offered the following resolution :

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas :

That the sum of \$ 97.16, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Contingent fund of the City of Austin, Texas, to pay interest on the General fund of the City of Austin, Texas, for the month of November 1915, per the attached and approved bill rendered by the Citizens Bank & Trust Co of the City of Austin, Texas.
