

**ORDINANCE NO. 20051117-072**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 25-8-514 OF THE CITY CODE TO ALLOW CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER QUALITY POND IN THE CRITICAL WATER QUALITY ZONE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Section 25-8-514 (*Pollution Prevention Required*) of the City Code is amended to allow construction of a pollution control structure in the critical water quality zone of the Barton Creek Watershed subject to Site Plan Permit No. SPC-05-0020DS.

**PART 2.** Construction of the pollution control structure allowed by this ordinance must include:


- (1) removing contaminated sediment; and
- (2) constructing two sedimentation filtration ponds located in Zilker Park, outside soccer practice areas; and
- (3) fencing the approximately 1.36 acre construction site during construction for safety; and
- (4) rerouting stormwater to discharge downstream of Barton Springs Pool; and
- (5) installing landscaping to minimize pond visibility from Barton Hills Drive.

**PART 3.** This ordinance takes effect on November 28, 2005.

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
