Approval of this request will allow the City Manager or the Executive Director of the Department of Aviation to execute the grants offered by the Federal Aviation Administration, the Transportation Security Administration, and other agencies of the United States Government related to Austin-Bergstrom International Airport during the Fiscal Year 2005-2006. This will allow the City to be in a position to quickly accept and execute grant offers as they are made available.

Grant amounts, as they may become available, would fund terminal area improvements, noise mitigation, airfield improvements, and security related projects at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport and reduce the need to utilize airport-generated capital. Grant funding may also reimburse operating expenses.

This was scheduled for review by the Airport Advisory Commission, but was not reviewed due to lack of a quorum at their past two meetings.

That the City Manager, the Director of the Department of Aviation, or their duly authorized designees, are authorized to accept one or more grants, including amendments to previously accepted grants, from the Federal Aviation Administration, the Transportation Security Administration, or other agencies of the United States Government, for the operation, improvement, noise mitigation, and security of Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 in Fiscal Year 2005-2006, on such terms and conditions as may be necessary, appropriate or required by law.
