Prior to annexation of this area, Travis County staff conducted an engineering investigation for Caddo Street. As a result of this investigation a speed limit of 25 miles per hour was recommended and installed for Caddo Street. The Transportation Division of the Public Works Department has accepted the previous study completed by Travis County and recommends adding the following to the City Code Section 12-4-24 (25 MPH Speed Limit):

Amendment to Code Section 12-4-24 (25 MPH Speed Limit):

Add: Caddo Street from North Lamar Boulevard (Loop 275) to Hornsby Street.

SUBJECT: Speed Limit Modifications on Caddo Street in Precinct Two.

Background:

On August 24, 1993, the Travis County Commissioners' Court delegated authority to the Director of PITD to issue traffic regulations under certain conditions. Those conditions require public notice and the expiration of seven days following the notice with no written request for a public hearing. State statute requires the Commissioners' Court to hold a public hearing on the proposed regulations if any resident of the County requests, in writing, the hearing within seven days of the public notice.

On November 27, 1994, PITD published notice of a proposed speed limit reduction from 30 mph to 25 mph on Caddo Street between North Lamar and Hornsby Street. We received one written request for a public hearing on this regulation, protesting the reduction of a 30 mph speed limit zone to a 25 mph speed limit zone on Caddo Street. A copy of the request is included in your backup as Attachment 1. This public hearing is in response to this request.

Current Status of Existing Traffic Regulation:

Current PITD records indicate that a 30 mph zone does exist on Caddo Street in its entirety. A portion of Caddo Street from North Lamar to Homsby Street varies in road width. The widths are from 20 feet to 17 feet respectively with no shoulder, open drainage on each side and no centerline striping at this road.

Page 2 Speed Limit Modifications

Recommendation:

The narrow width at portions of this road create a hazard to pedestrians walking or jogging along this section of roadway.

Our evaluation indicated that a reduction in the speed limit along this section of roadway will offer substantial benefit to pedestrian activity in the neighborhood as well as motorists not familiar with this road.

PITD Engineering Staff recommends approval of a reduced speed limit of 25 mph on Caddo Street as listed on the attached order.

A public hearing has been scheduled for March 28, 1995, pursuant to this action.

This recommendation is made in accordance with Texas Civil Statutes Article 6702-1.

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ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 12-4-24 OF THE CITY CODE BY ADDING A PORTION OF CADDO STREET TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-24 (Maximum Speed Limit of 25 Miles Per Hour) of the City Code is amended to add:

Caddo Street from North Lamar Boulevard (Loop 275) to Hornsby Street.

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

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PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on _____, 2005.
