
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-63 (20 Mile Per Hour School Zones) of the City Code is amended as follows:

Mesa Drive from 91 feet north of Austin Woods Drive to 250 feet south of [north-eurb-of] Greenflint Lane (Hill Elementary School and Anderson High School).

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

A Traffic Engineering Investigation has been conducted by this department to determine if an existing Reduced Speed School Zone should be extended on Mesa Drive south of Greenflint Lane for Anderson High School.

The following information was collected and analyzed.

1 - The Proximity of the School Crossing to the School:

There are three crosswalks for crossing Mesa Drive in this school zone. The nearest crossing to Anderson High School is on the west side of the campus at the intersection of Mesa Drive and Greenflint Lane. The other crosswalks are located in the middle of the school zone at the intersection of Mesa Drive and Cima Serena, and at the north end of the school zone at the intersection of Mesa Drive and Austin Woods Drive. This school zone services both Anderson High and Hill Elementary schools.

Sight distance on Mesas Drive at the intersection with Greenflint Lane, Cima Serena, and Rockford Lane is clear.

8 - Sidewalk Location:

There is a five foot wide sidewalk in place on the west side of Mesa Drive and a 6 foot wide sidewalk on the east side of Mesa Drive.

9 - Other

Parents picking up and dropping off students park on both sides of Mesa Drive adjacent to Anderson High School and wait for children to come to and from their vehicles. The majority of the parked vehicles are south of the crosswalk and out of the school zone. There is a school crosswalk located at the intersection of Mesa Drive and Greenflint Lane near the location where parents park to drop off or pick up children. The area becomes quite congested at peak school hours and the amount of pedestrian traffic in and around the crosswalk is significant. This area is also where school buses stage to on-load and off-load students.

<u>General Comments</u>: The current school zone does not adequately cover the marked crosswalk at Greenflint Lane.

Based on the analysis of this information, it is my engineering judgment that the Reduced Speed School Zone of 20 mph during specified times on Mesa Drive <u>should be</u> extended an additional 250 south of Greenflint Lane. This results in having a school zone from 91 feet north of Austin Woods Drive to 250 feet south of Greenflint Lane.


