

ORDINANCE NO. 20061116-081

AN ORDINANCE SETTING MAYOR AND COUNCIL SALARIES AND COMPENSATION; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 000511-71.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Council salaries were last adjusted in 2000. To provide for an annual cost-of-living increase of 3.5% for each year City of Austin employees received a 3.5% increase since 2000 and to provide for a further increase of 8% in base salary, equal to the contribution the City makes to the Employee Retirement System on behalf of its non-civil service employees, the Council sets the salaries for Mayor and Council Members as follows:

- (1) the Mayor's salary is set at \$67,981 annually, and an automobile allowance of \$5,400 annually;
- (2) the Council Members' salaries are set at \$57,736 annually, and an automobile allowance of \$5,400 annually.

PART 2. A cost-of-living adjustment will be considered in the annual budget process at the beginning of each fiscal year. The adjustment will be equal to the base percentage amount established for "meets expectations" compensation adjustments for non-Civil Service employees for that fiscal year.

PART 3. The City Manager is directed to take the necessary administrative actions to implement the salary adjustment effective as of the beginning pay period of Fiscal Year 2006-2007.


PART 4. Ordinance No. 000511-71 is repealed.


