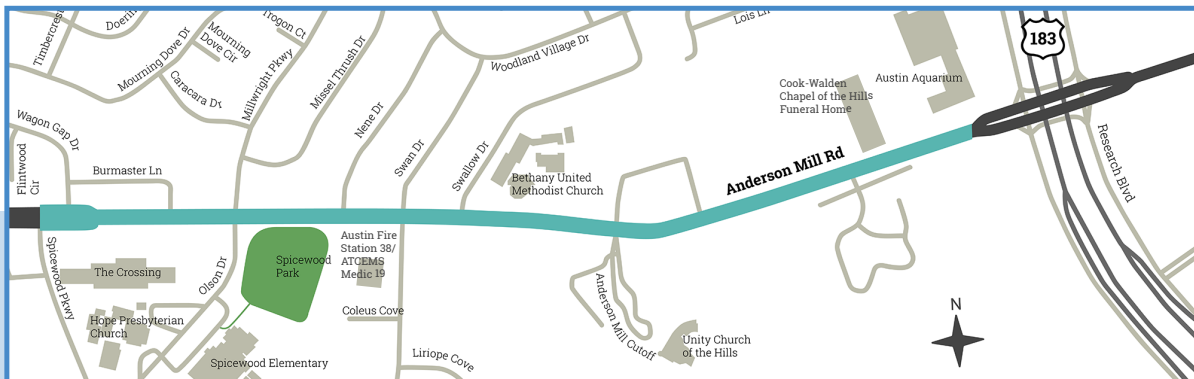


As part of the 2016 Mobility Bond, the City of Austin is beginning construction of long-term safety and mobility improvements on Anderson Mill Road between US 183 and Spicewood Parkway.



*Not all roads or businesses may be named or shown.

This project includes:

- A new center left-turn lane with turning bays between US 183 and Spicewood Parkway
- A new raised median near US 183
- An extended right turn lane on Anderson Mill Road eastbound approaching US 183
- A new Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon at 9707 Anderson Mill Road
- A new lane configuration and signal upgrades at the Anderson Mill Road/Olson Drive intersection
- Continuous shared use paths on both sides of the road between US 183 and Spicewood Parkway for people riding bikes and people walking
- Water quality improvements, including new raingardens



Construction Impacts

This project will be constructed in phases by M.A. Smith, the General Contractor for this work, with lane closures needed throughout the project area to make space for crews to work safely. Access to all properties will be maintained during construction.



Timeline

Construction begins this summer and is anticipated to last up to 18 months. All work is dependent on weather and any other unanticipated delays.



COVID-19

All construction is identified as critical infrastructure work under Governor Abbott's March 31, 2020 Executive Order (No. GA-14) and is considered essential. The COVID-19 pandemic is being monitored every day and construction schedules may be impacted.
