
Get the facts about

Mpox is a viral infection that spreads from person to person through close contact. It usually causes mild but painful symptoms, like these:



Most people who get mpox get it from close contact, including sex, with someone who is showing symptoms. But people who have mpox may be able to give it to others up to four days before they show symptoms.

IT TAKES TWO!

You can stay safe from getting sick with mpox by

- ✓ Getting the mpox vaccine -- It takes two doses!
- \checkmark Getting tested if you think you may have mpox
- \checkmark Getting tested if you've been in close contact with someone who has mpox

Don't have sex or close contact with strangers who may have mpox.

Talk to your primary care provider for more information about mpox testing or getting the mpox vaccine.
