This photo-sculpture is a futuristic transformation of the city based on real images of downtown Austin in daylight combined with the dream of space travel. The sculpture consists of over 126 uniquely cut and shaped panels with photo-imagery applied. The sculpture spans over 18 feet and the top towers above the concourse floor over 32 feet high. A night version of the *Cruiser* can be seen on the east mezzanine wall across from gates 6-7.
