As part of the local cultural expressions in the airport architecture, many of the restroom interiors on the secure side of the terminal possess colorful and whimsical tiles embedded into the walls. The hand-painted glazed tiles found in both the men & women restrooms depict recognizable caricatures of plants, animals and scenes native to the Austin region. Measuring over 10" in width, the tiles have decorative border patterns and center images with over 40 different versions of Austin icons.
