PARKING CHANGES COMING THIS MONTH Alexander Avenue (Manor Road to E 17th Street)

As part of the installation of street design changes on Alexander Avenue, Clarkson Avenue, and E 34th Street, parking changes are coming later this October to Alexander Avenue between Manor Road and E 17th Street. This street space will be used for a new two-way protected bikeway and shorter pedestrian crossings. These changes are the result of a public engagement process in 2019.

Installation of new "No Parking" signs is scheduled to begin in late October in the areas indicated on the map below. After "No Parking" signs are in place, 48 hours are available to relocate parked vehicles. After 48 hours, vehicles parked in the new two-way protected bikeway will be towed out of the way. In addition, temporary parking restrictions will be implemented where necessary to facilitate the installation of the project. During implementation, orange cones will be placed along the east side of the roadway to support the installation of physical protection for the bikeway.

The new bikeway is part of an Austin Transportation Department multimodal improvement project that includes a new all ages and abilities bikeway, improved walkways and shared use path, and upgraded crossings on E 34th Street, Clarkson Avenue, and Alexander Avenue from E 17th Street to Cherrywood Road. The street design changes are anticipated to enhance safety and mobility for everyone who uses these streets. For more information on this project's history, visit AustinTexas.gov/AlexanderAve.

IMPLEMENTATION

Bikeway implementation is scheduled to begin in October and should take about three weeks to complete. Alexander Avenue will remain open at all times during implementation. All work is dependent on weather and any other unanticipated delays. The COVID-19 pandemic is being monitored every day and construction schedules may be impacted.
