

APD Evidence Section Security Audit

Issued: June 2011

Our audit objective was to determine whether existing APD policies, procedures, and processes provide reasonable assurance that evidence is safeguarded and stored to meet chain of custody standards. The audit scope included the Evidence Section's current security operations and facilities. We reviewed the Evidence Section's procedures and tested its automated inventory system, as well logical and physical security functionality.

The details of our findings related to the logical and physical security objectives were presented to the Audit & Finance Committee in executive session on June 22, 2011, and there was no public discussion on this item pursuant to Government Code §551.076 - *Security Audits*.
