## **PUBLIC PROCESS**

In late 2019, the Austin Transportation Department began a public process to collect community input on safety and mobility needs for people using Cameron and Dessau roads from 51<sup>st</sup> Street to Parmer Lane. Input received from the community is being evaluated as part of the development of a proposal.

# **SURVEY INPUT**

A survey was available at an initial listening session and on the project website from November 21st through December 22nd, 2019. Survey input is being used to find design solutions. All survey response data is available on the Cameron and Dessau roads website.
