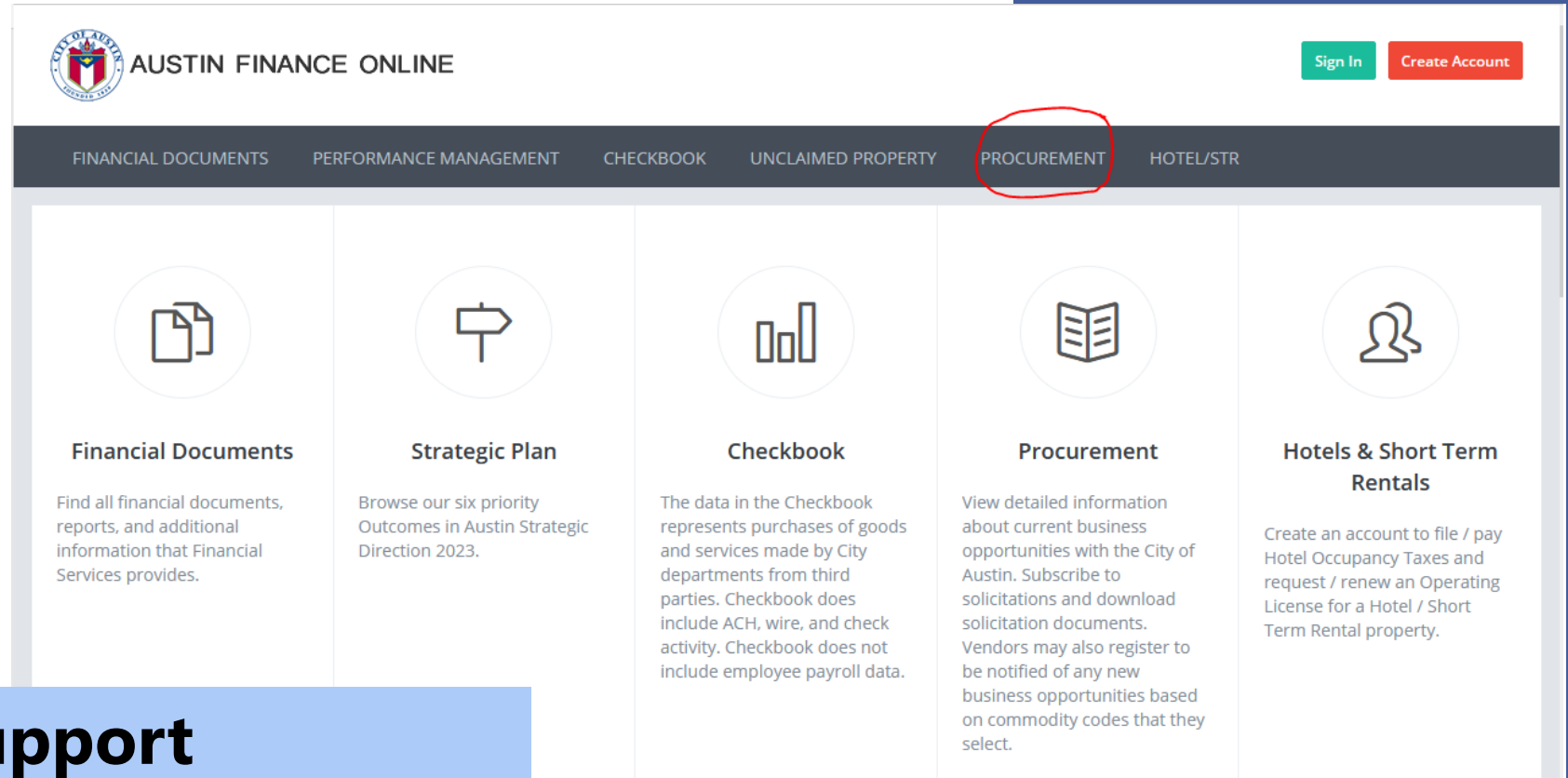

CLMC864 Meadow Lake Blvd Street Extension

Description: The proposed 1,240 LF roadway includes two vehicular travel lanes with parallel parking and sidewalk on both sides. A two-way bicycle lane runs along the west side of the road and is protected by intermittent barrier curb. A proposed waterline runs the entire length of the road and connects to existing waterline at both ends.

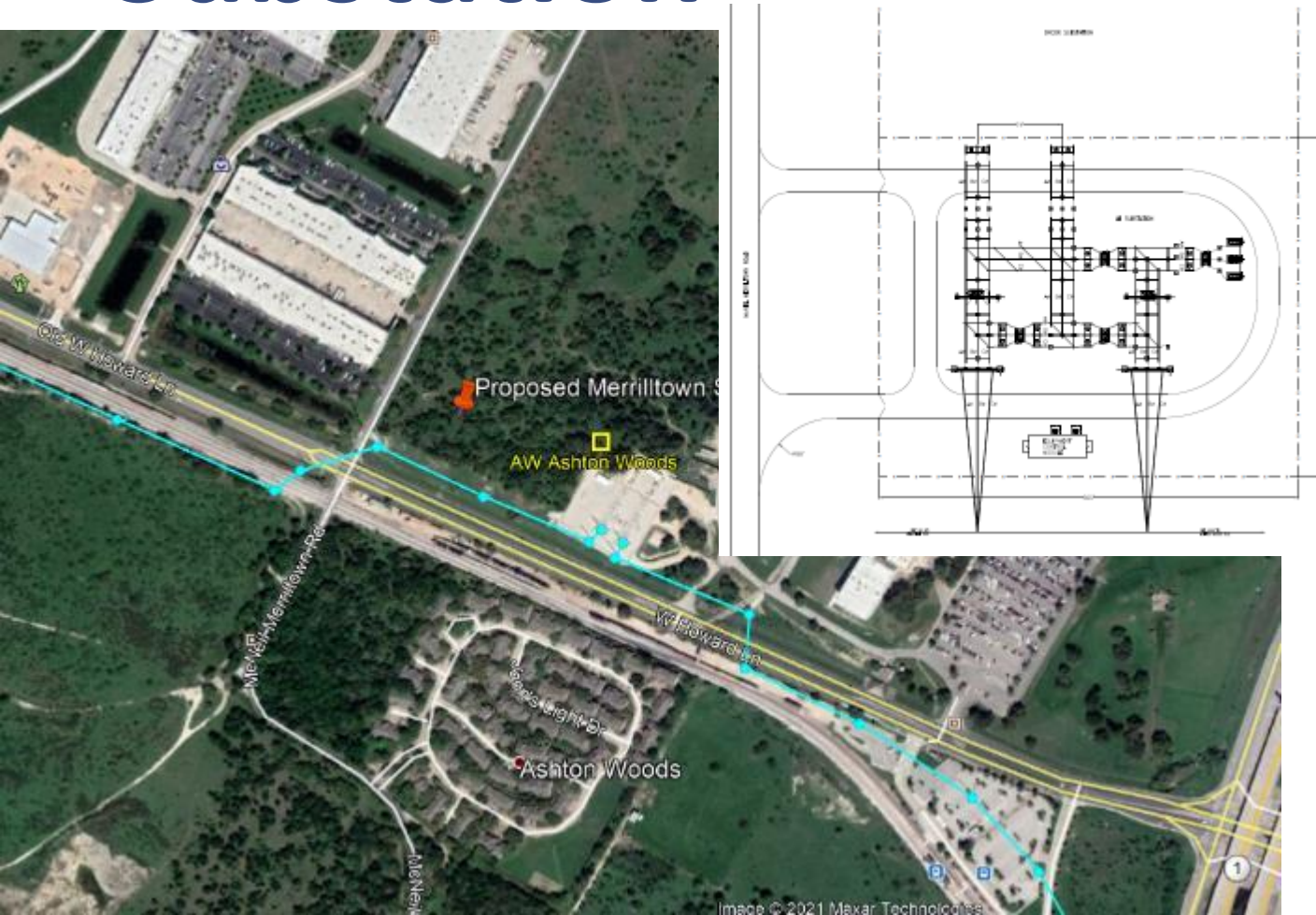

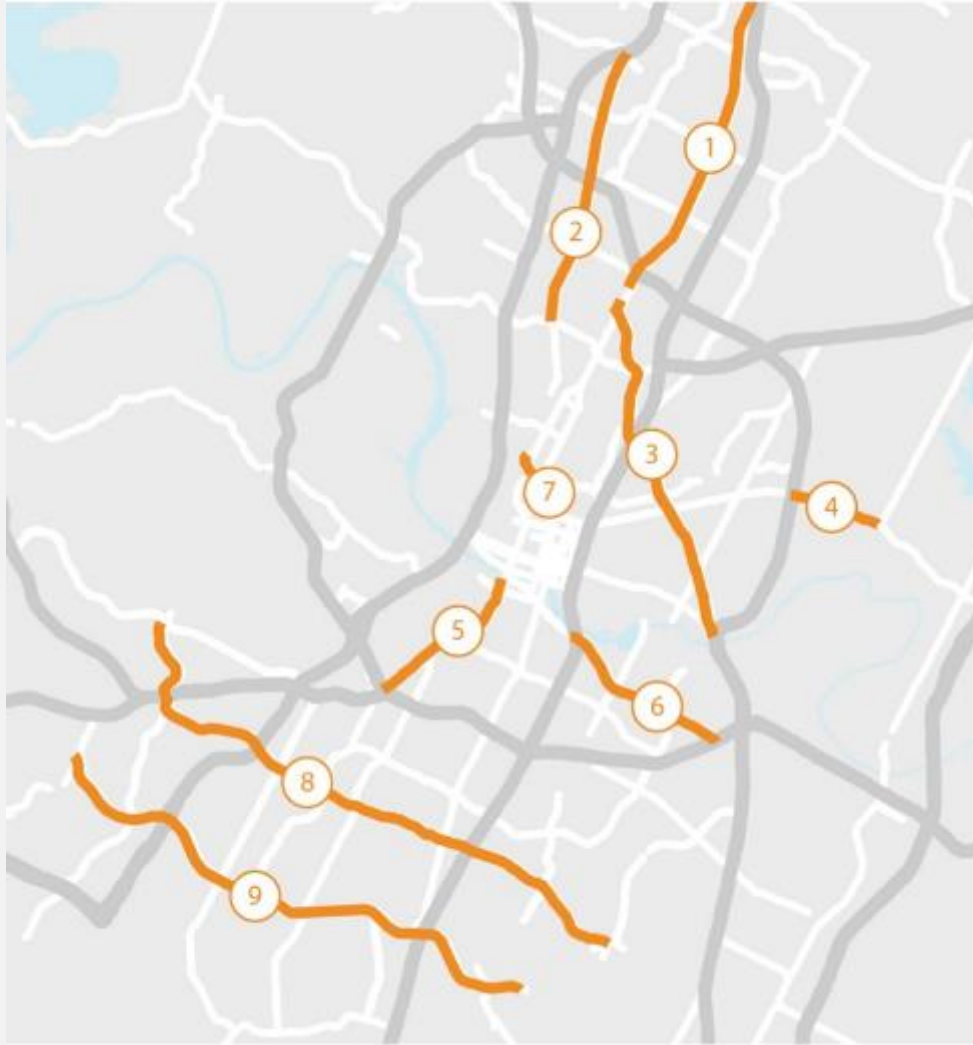

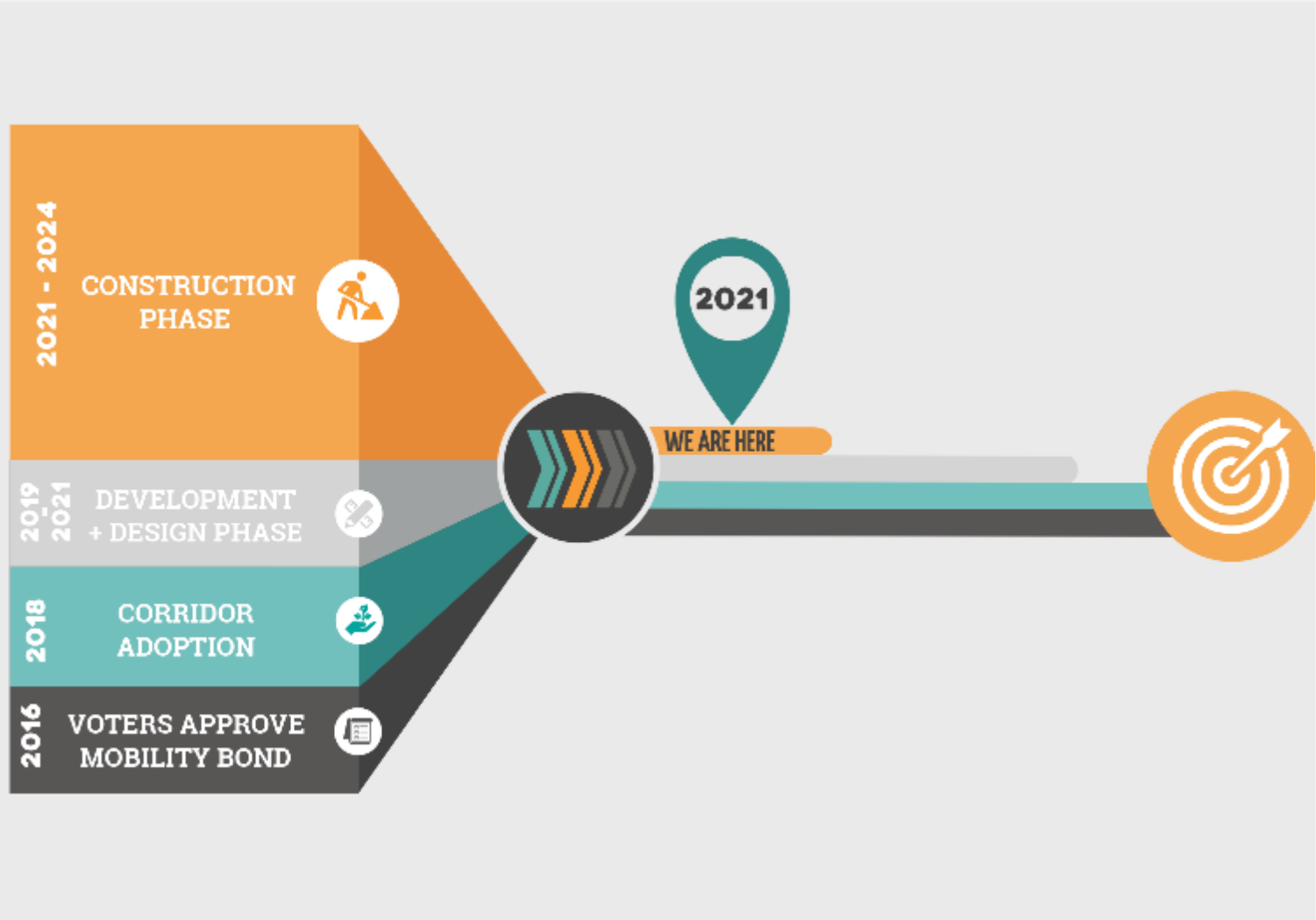

Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvement IDIQ

SCOPE - Construction of sidewalks, share-use-paths, pedestrian ramps, driveways, retaining walls, handrails, bikeways, striping, shoulder widening, bus stop ADA upgrades, and associated construction in response to City of Austin requests.

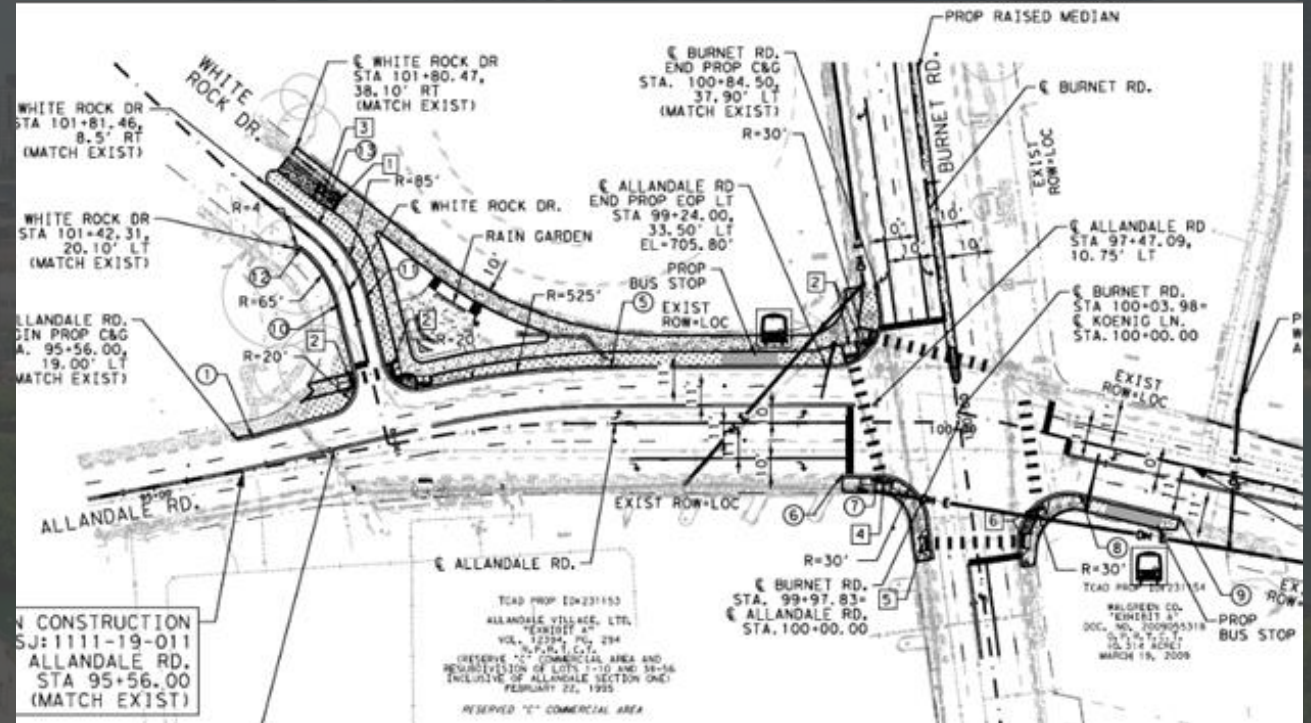

Burnet Rd./Koenig Lane Intersection Improvements

SCOPE - Upgraded bicycle and pedestrian facilities, added right turn lane from Eastbound Koenig Ln to Southbound Burnet Rd, transit stop enhancements, medians, pocket green with placemaking amenities, and upgraded signals.

- Construction Est. - 2M - \$3.5M
- Est. Bid - Fall 2021



Airport Blvd. - North Lamar Blvd to 55th St

SCOPE - Construction of continuous bicycle and pedestrian facilities, medians, improved pedestrian lighting, transit stop improvements, intersection improvements, upgraded traffic signals at 5 intersections and a new signal and crosswalk at Clayton Lane.

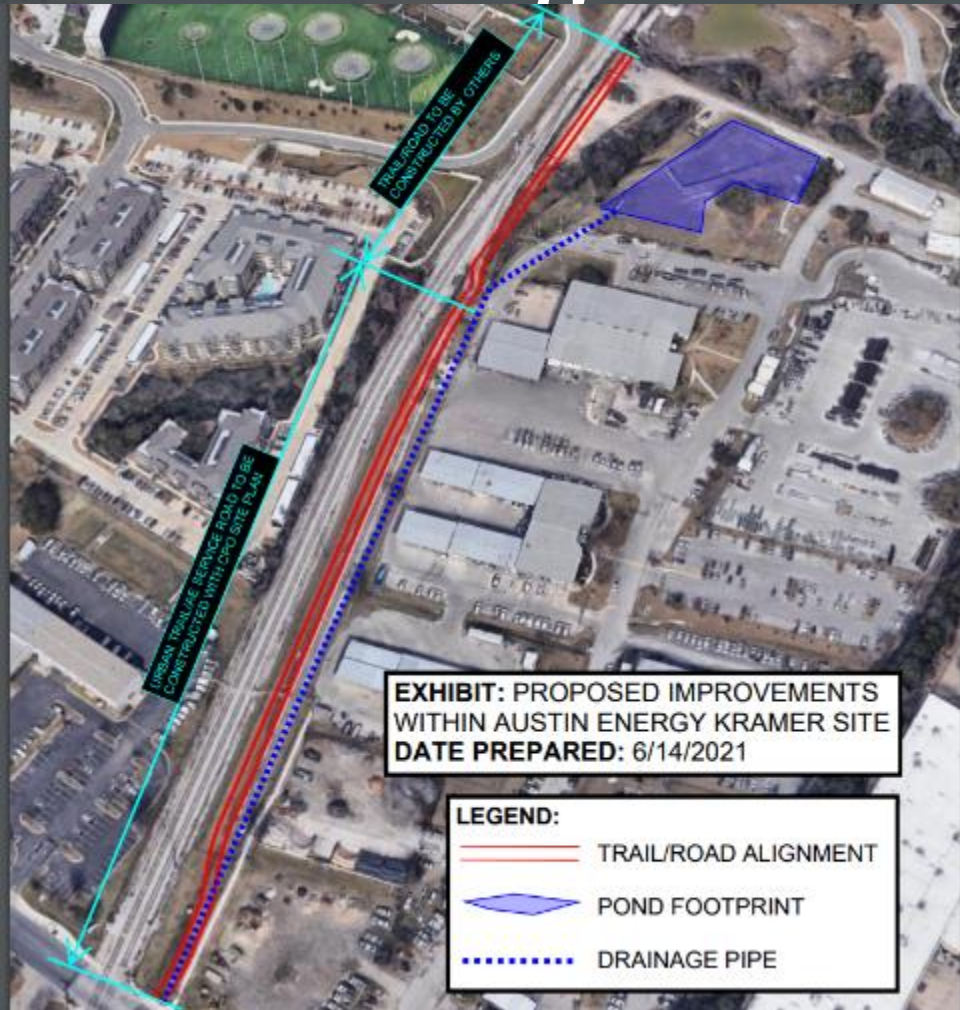

Burnet Corridor – Kramer Site Drainage Improvements

SCOPE – Downstream drainage improvements for future Burnet Corridor drainage upgrades and a segment Red Line Urban Trail

Slaughter Ln./Escarpment Blvd. Intersection Improvements

SCOPE - Additional left turn lane from Westbound Slaughter to Southbound Escarpment, traffic signal upgrades, high-visibility crosswalks, improved bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

- Construction Est. - \$1.5M - \$2.5M
- Est. Bid - Summer 2022



William Cannon Dr - Running Water Dr to McKinney Falls Pkwy (CAMPO Grant)

SCOPE - Roadway widening from two to four lanes, new bridge over Marble Creek, continuous bicycle and pedestrian facilities, landscaping enhancements.

- Construction Est. - \$12.5M - \$15M
- Est. Bid - Summer 2022
