




MAP OF CORRIDORS AND LIMITS

Bicycle & Pedestrian Improvement IDIQ




Burnet Rd./Koenig Lane Intersection

Improvements

SCOPE - Upgraded bicycle and pedestrian facilities, added right turn lane from Eastbound Koenig Ln to Southbound Burnet Rd, transit stop enhancements, medians, pocket green with placemaking amenities, and upgraded signals.

#### Airport Blvd. - North Lamar Blvd to 55th St








View of Future Improvements at E William Cannon Dr from Running Water Dr to McKinney Falls Pkwy


