Looking for a secure place to keep the things that matter the most?

As part of the Clean City Strategy, The City of Austin has created a free downtown storage facility with daily access morning, afternoon and evening to lighten your load during challenging times. At Violet KeepSafe, you will have a secure, personal bin where you can store items for a few hours or months at a time, making it the perfect spot to keep your vital documents, family memories, clothing, bedding, and more.

700 E 7th St, Austin, TX 78701

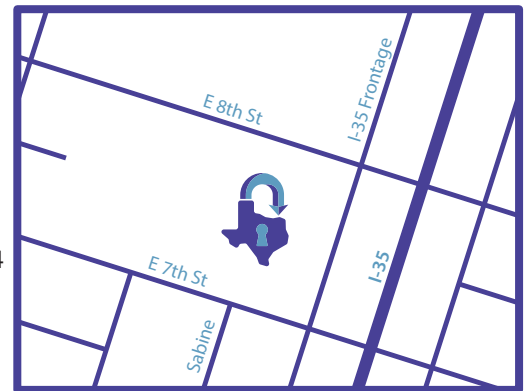
in the former Austin Municipal Court Building

Hours:

Open every day, 7a.m. - 7 p.m.
(closed daily from 11a.m. - 1p.m.)

Access:

Walk-in or call 512-974-1294



How it Works:

- Visit Violet KeepSafe Storage during business hours.
- Sign a waiver after reviewing the rules of the facility with the attendant.
- The attendant will assign you a storage bin and combination lock. Once you've stored your items, lock your bin and go about your day.
- To access your storage bin, give the attendant your name, bin number or combination. They will bring your bin up to the access area where you'll be able to get whatever you need.

Food, flammables items, animals, plants, explosives, weapons, drug paraphernalia, and firearms are not allowed in the storage bins.
