I understand I may schedule #114 continuance of work inspection for the inspector to verify if work has continued. If the inspector has determined that work has not continued the permit will not receive a passed inspection, and the permit will expire at the end of 180 days from the time of issuance or the last documented pass or fail inspection. An inspection result of "failed/no work performed" or "cancelled" will not keep a permit active.
