Proposed Rules for Demolition Notification Now Available

Stakeholder Comments Due by January 12, 2021

The Austin City Council adopted a new [Demolition Notification Ordinance](#) in October 2020, addressing recommendations from the 2017 [Demolition Process Final Report](#). The [City of Austin Building Criteria Manual](#) is being updated to amend the rules needed to implement the new ordinance.
