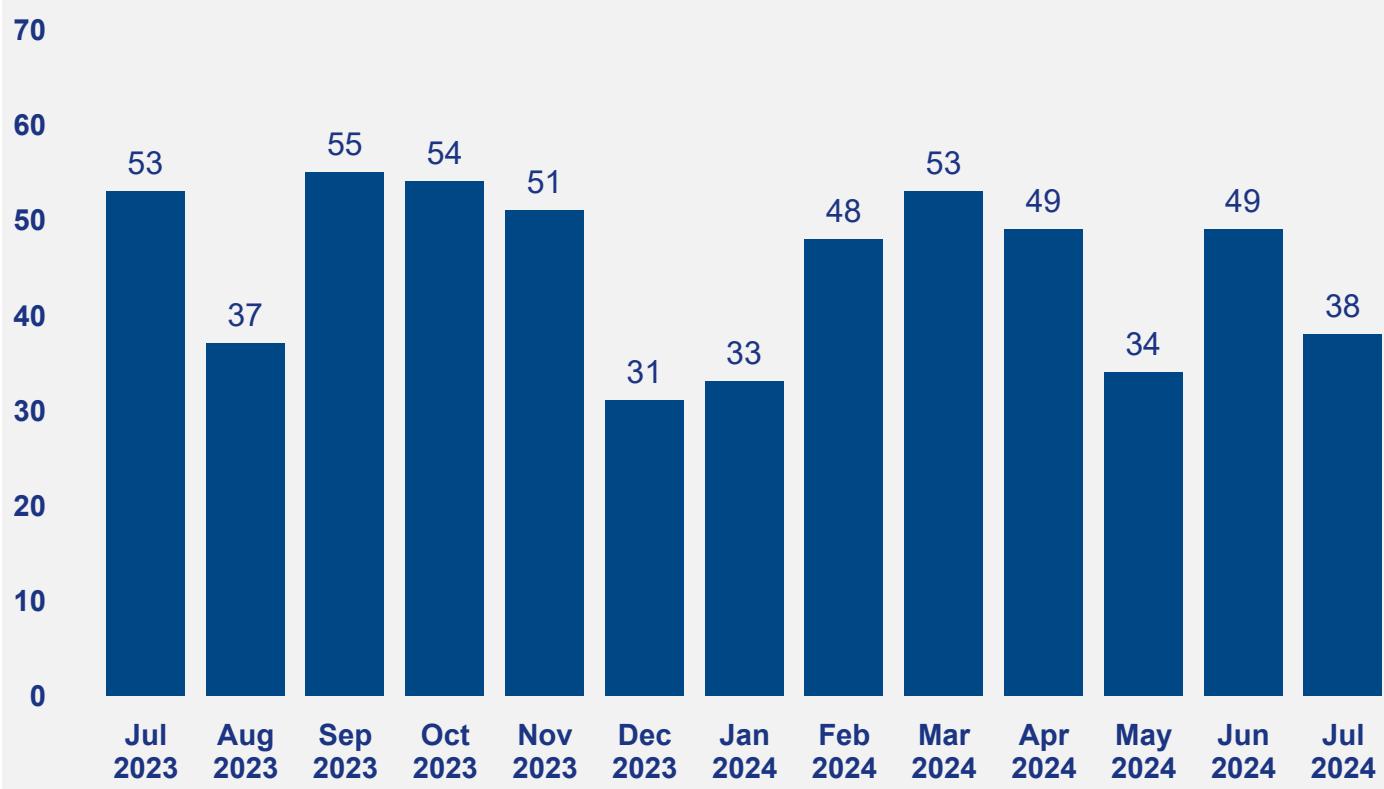




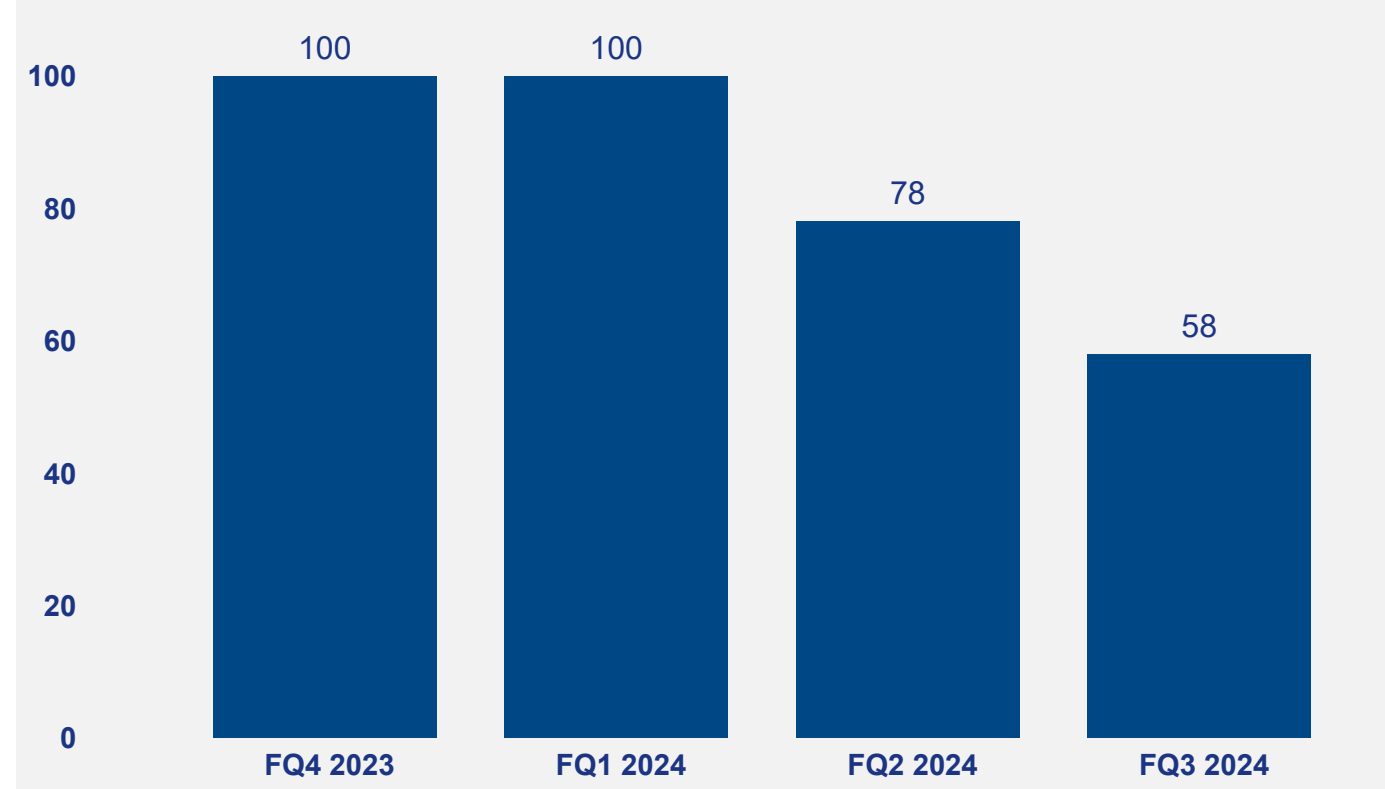
City of Austin: Site Plan Metric Report

This report provides regular updates on volume and performance of the site plan review process. It includes metrics at a high level and breaks them down by each phase of the process to provide a comprehensive view. Data is provided by month and by Fiscal Quarter (FQ). Measures marked with an asterisk (*) are considered lagging measures. This means they are reported in the time period in which the permit is issued. However, they incorporate review work completed during previous periods. Durations are measured in calendar days.

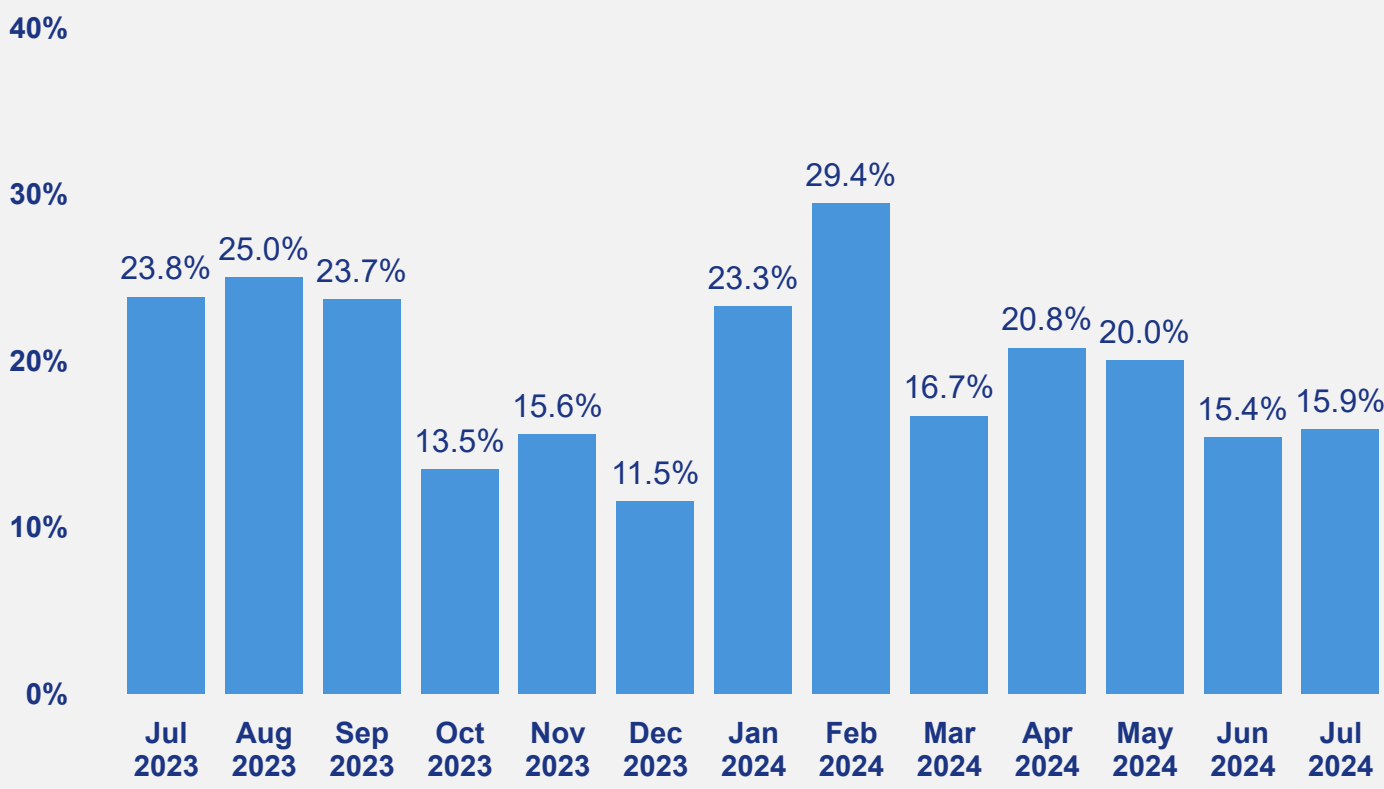
Count of Site Plan Applications Received



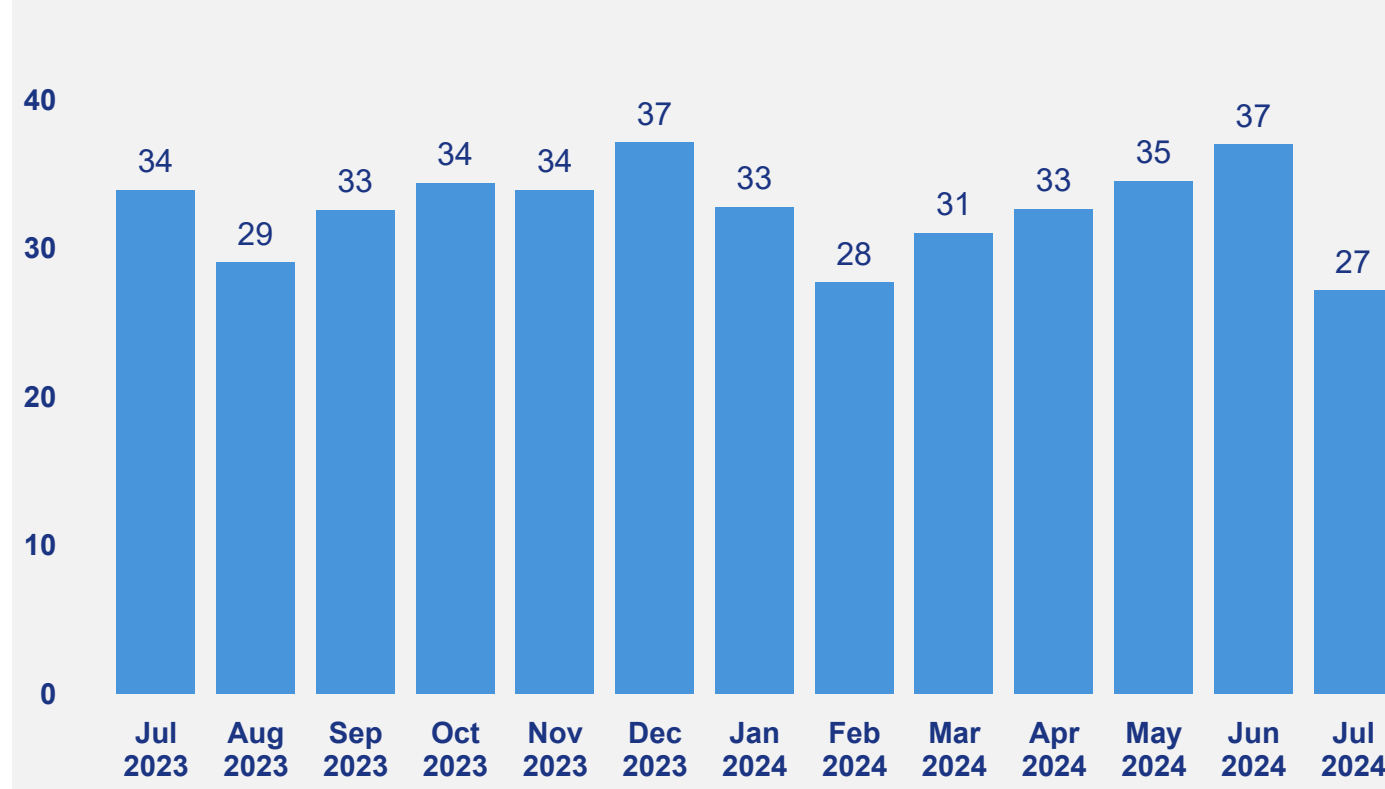
Count of Site Plan Permits Issued



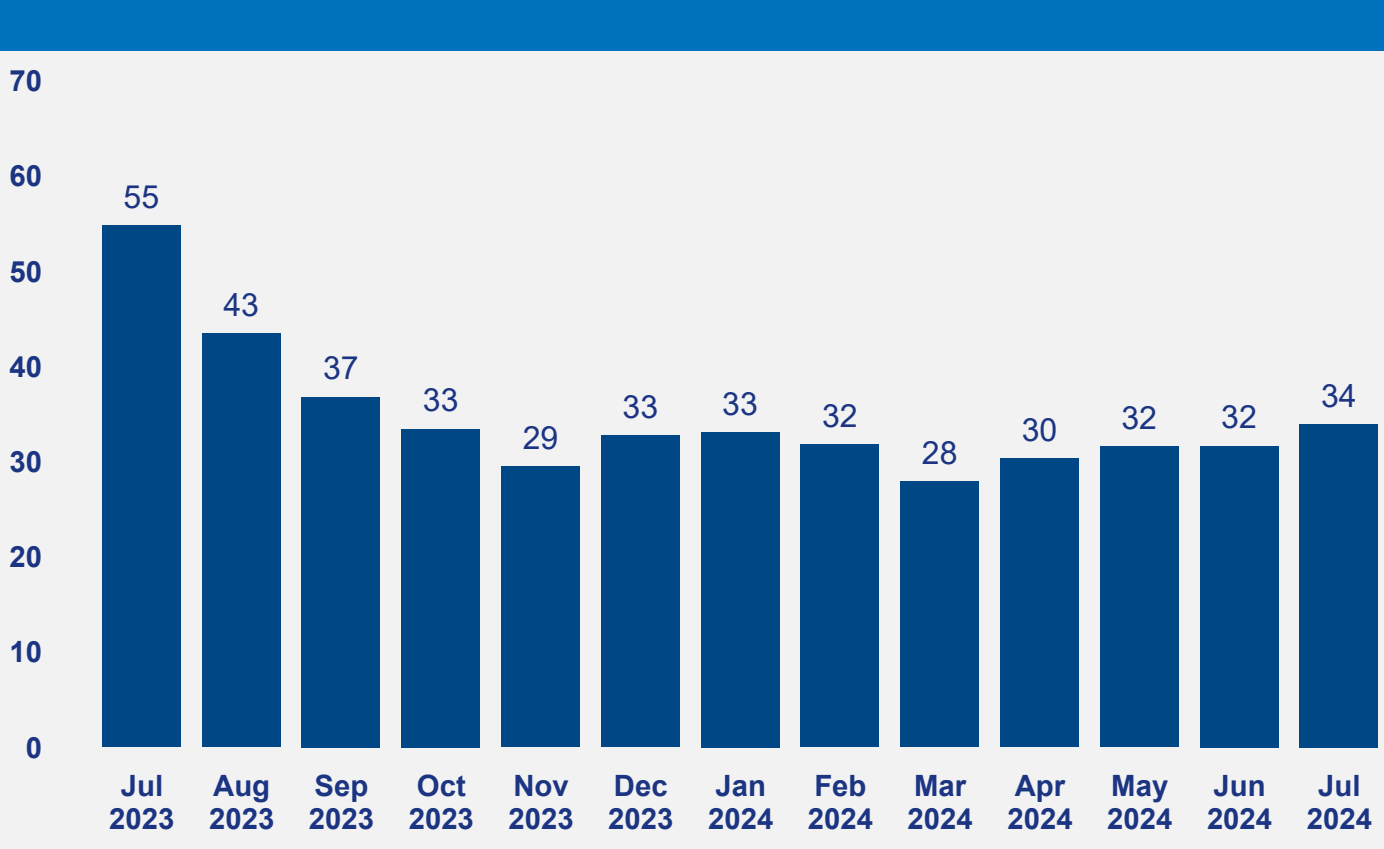
Percent of Applications Passing Completeness Check on Initial Submission



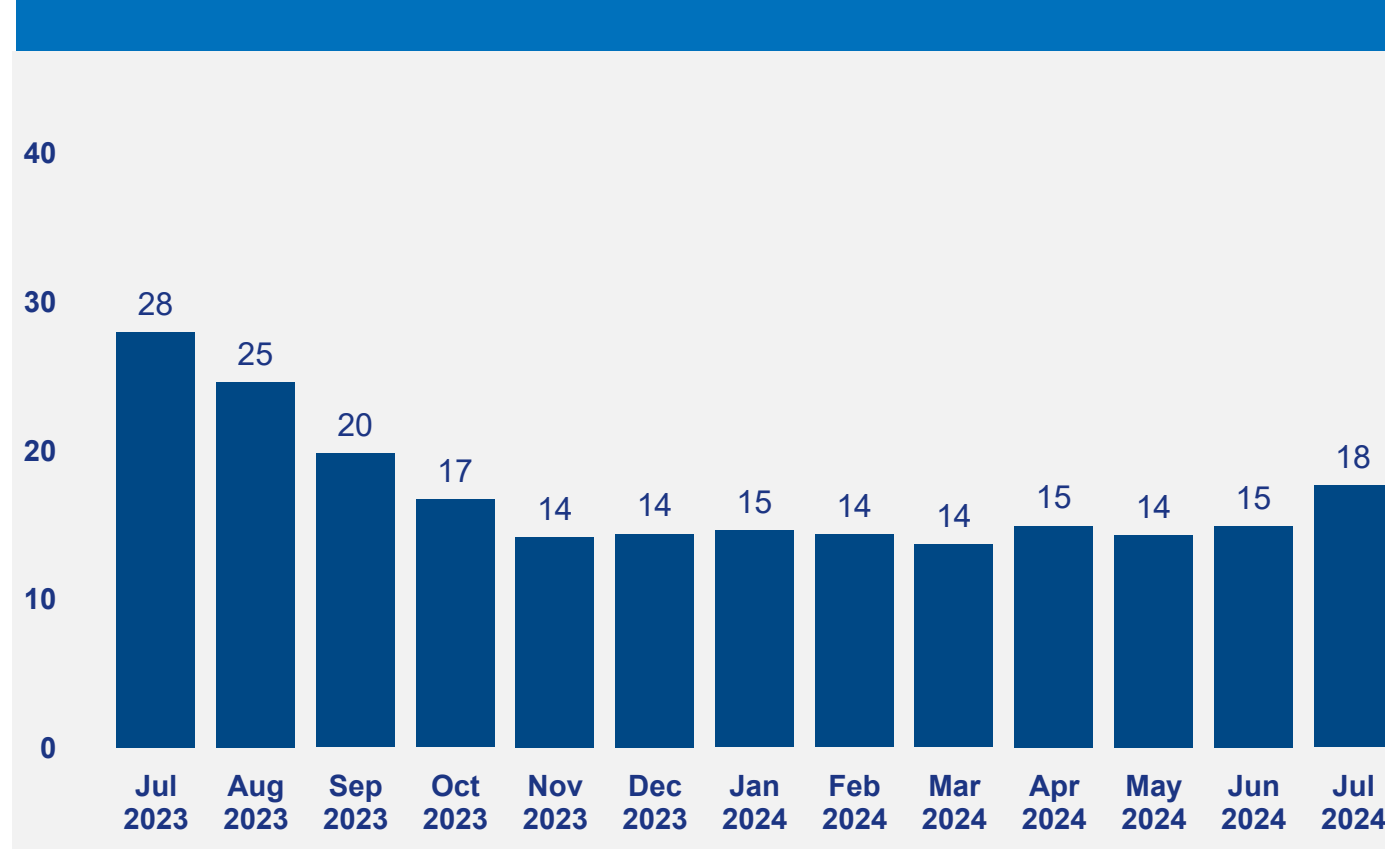
Average Number of Days Spent in Completeness Check



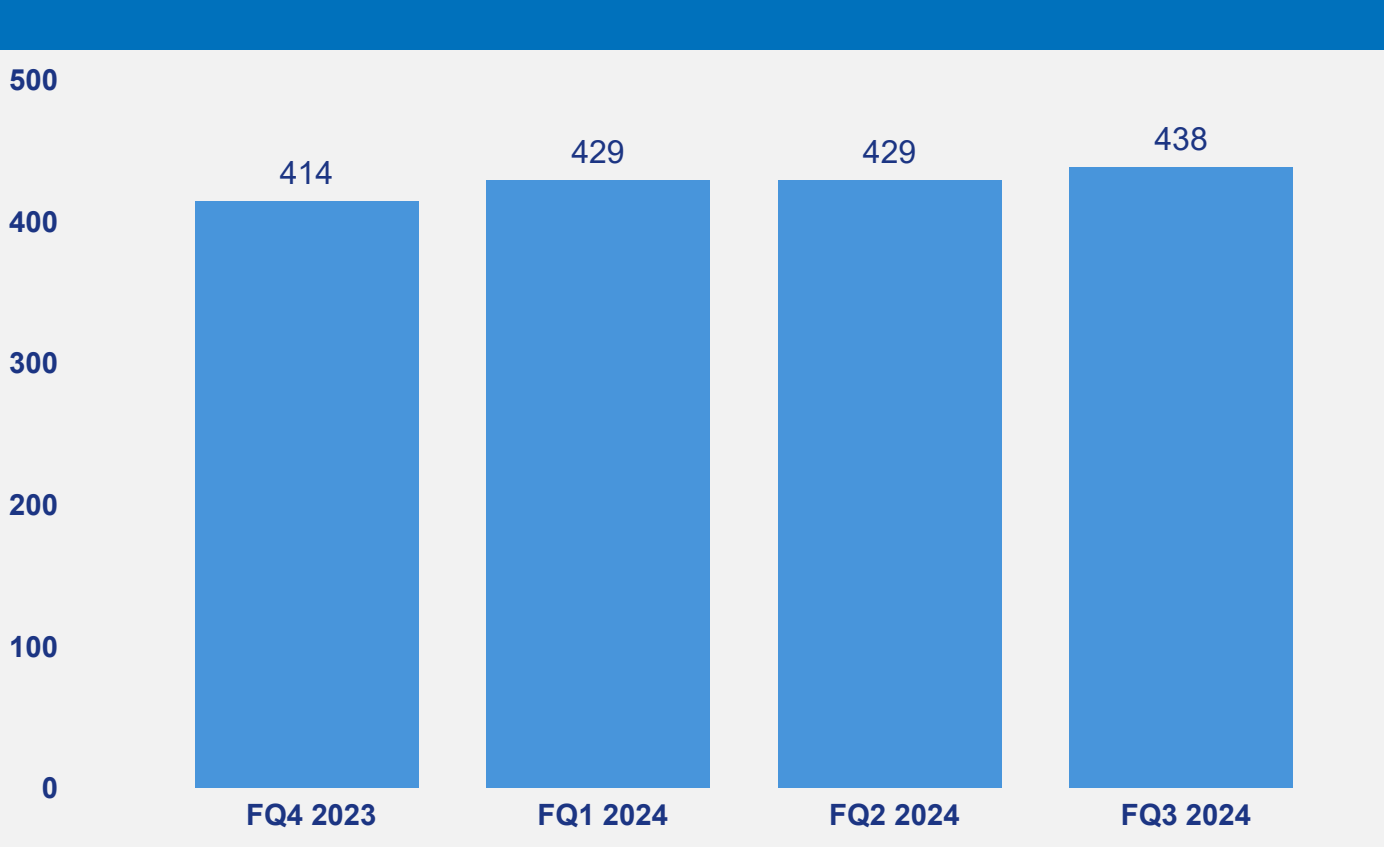
Average Days in Initial Review Cycle



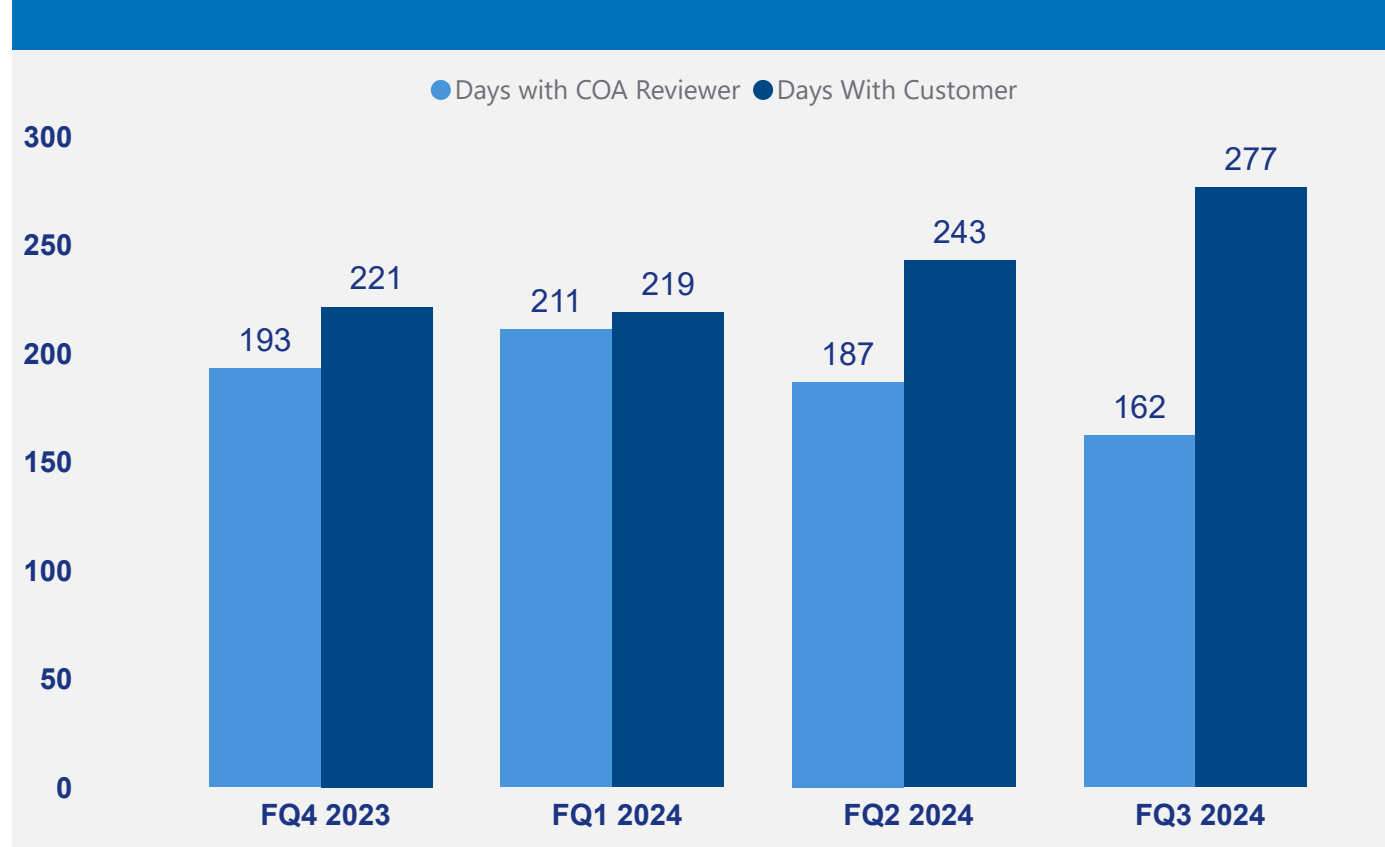
Average Days in Update Review Cycles



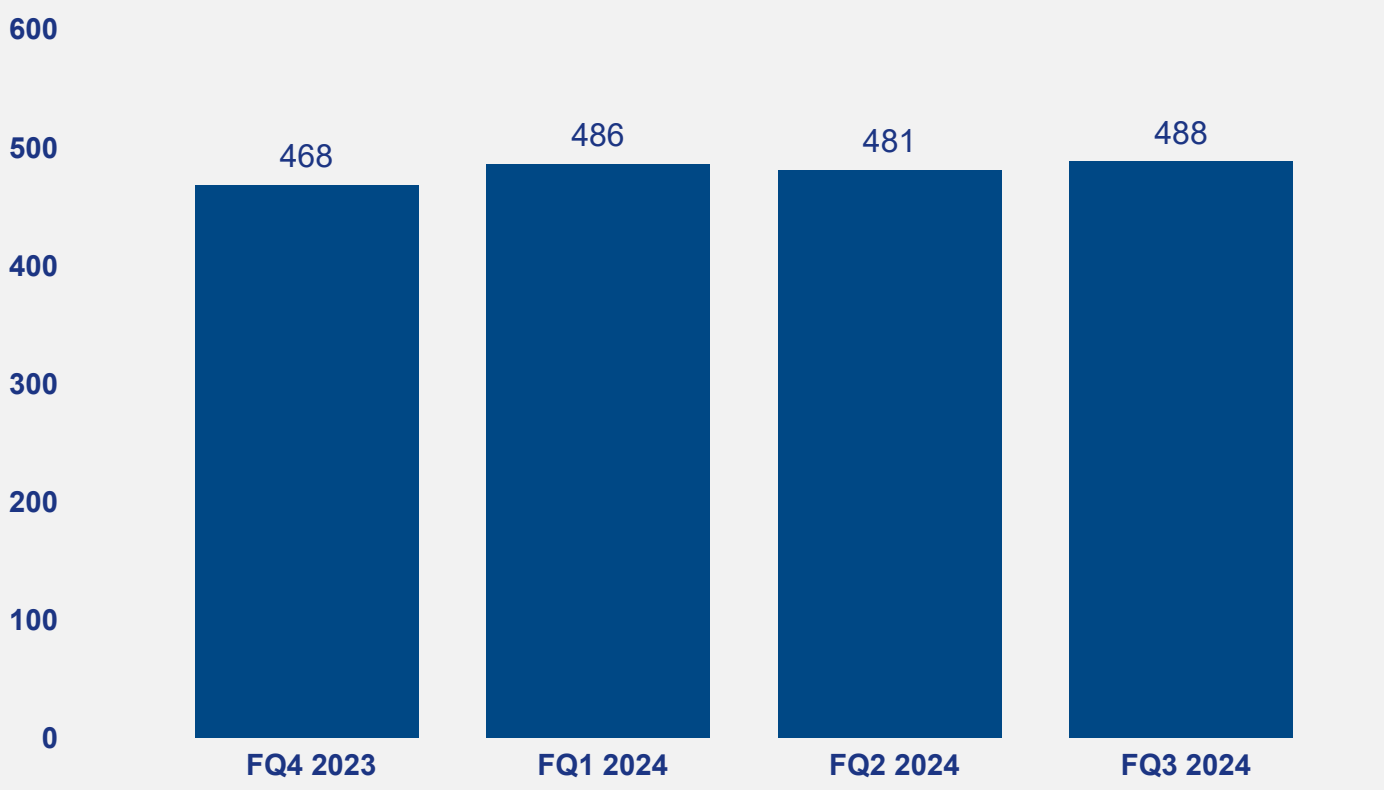
Total Days in Formal Review*



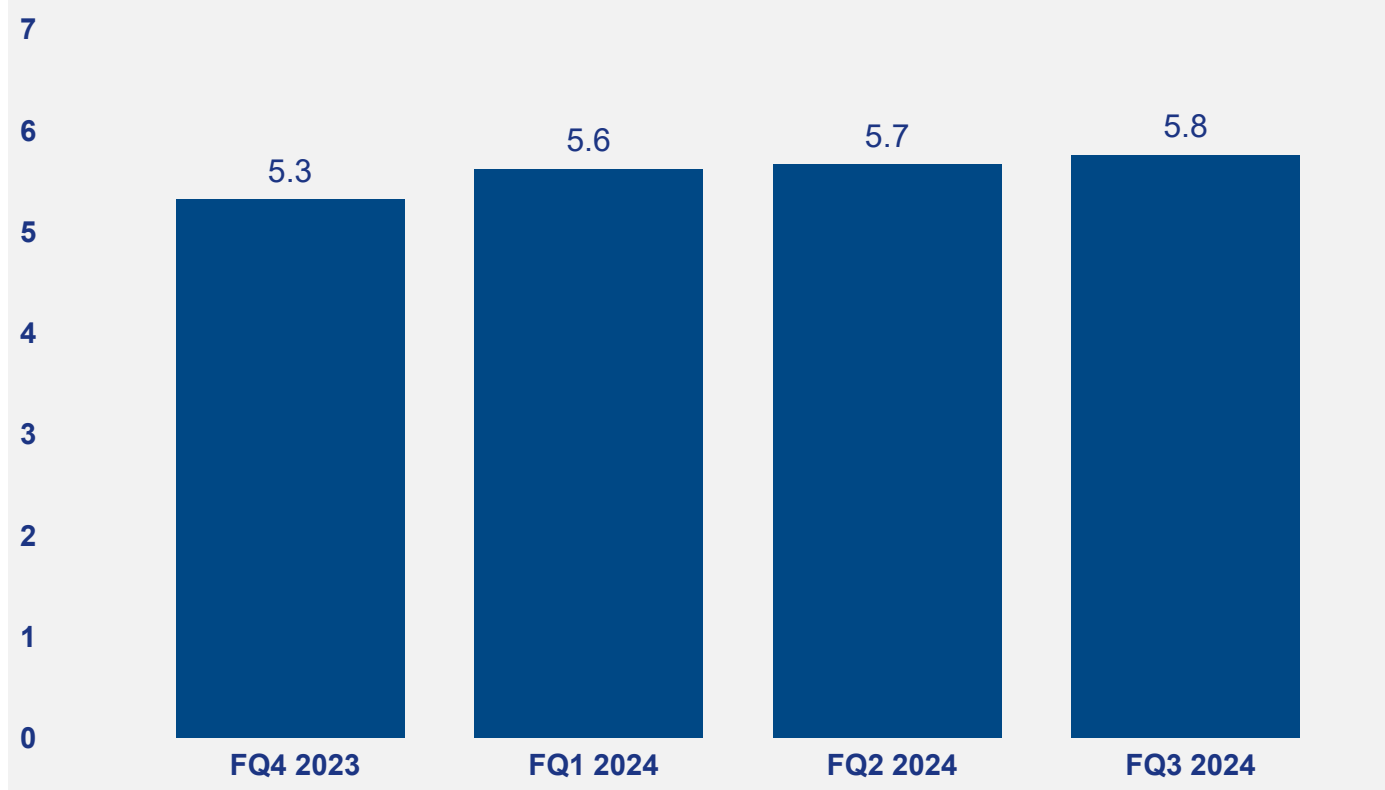
Breakdown of Days for Staff and Applicant During Formal Review*
