Dear Neighbor:

This notice is to update you of upcoming construction related to the Red River Area Improvements on **Red River Street.** After minor delays, construction is expected to begin the week of October 11th, with improvements beginning along Red River Street from 6th Street to 7th Street. This section of **Red River Street** is being improved through sidewalk repair and replacement, pedestrian mobility enhancements (traffic bulb outs, curb cuts, etc.), pedestrian scale solar lighting, as well as landscaping improvements. The work will involve the demolition and removal of existing sidewalk infrastructure, pouring new concrete, and installing lighting and landscaping elements. This will increase pedestrian safety and mobility, while enhancing the character of the Red River Cultural District.

How will this affect traffic and street access?

The street will remain open to traffic; access to driveways will be available, unless specifically addressed with impacted business. We encourage everyone to use extra caution while in the work zone.

To Help Us Do a Quality Job:

- Do not park along the curb within the work zone between the hours of 6:30 a.m. 5:30 p.m.
- To allow for proper curing (drying) of the concrete, please do not use until the cones have been removed.
- Follow all work zone traffic signs, cones, and flaggers to help direct you.
- Reduce speed; travel slowly and cautiously in the work zone.





As always, schedules are projected as accurately as possible but are subject to change due to the nature of maintenance construction and weather. Thank you for your patience and please contact us with any questions or concerns.
