The Economic Development Department's Cultural Arts Division presents the People's Gallery.

Since 2005, Austin City Hall has been an annual showcase for works by Austin artists and arts organizations. The People's Gallery reflects the artistic excellence and diversity of Austin. It also promotes the City of Austin's cultural and economic initiatives. Over 140 artworks are displayed throughout City Hall for the enjoyment of residents and visitors.

A diverse panel of three local visual arts professionals served as the jury this year: Meena Matocha, Dave McClinton, and Kemi Yemi-Ese. The exhibition was managed and designed by Exhibit Coordinator Suzanne Burton, with assistance from Penny Rodriguez, and Cultural Arts staff.

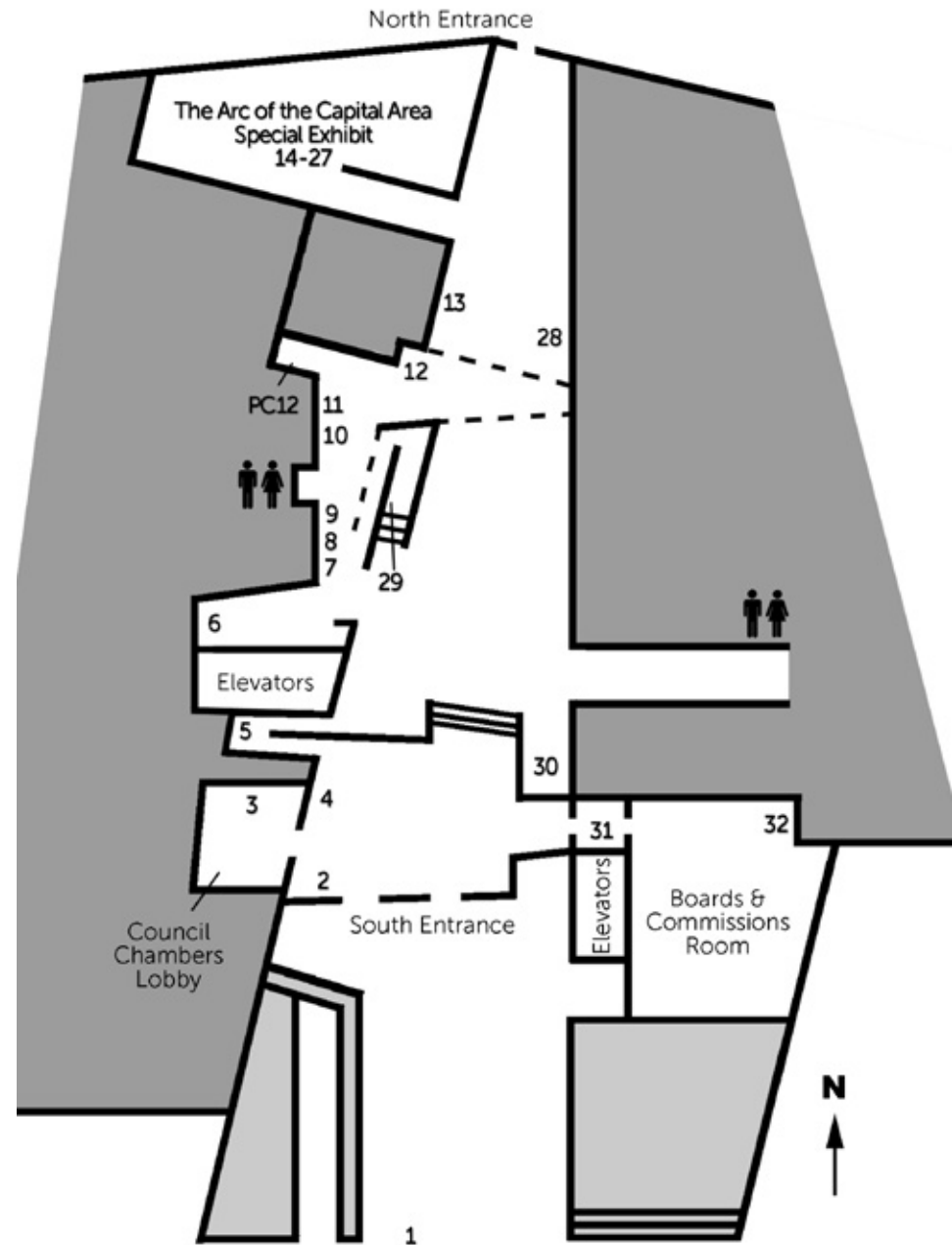
Voting ends October 30, 2020, and the winner will be announced at the opening reception of the 2021 People's Gallery exhibition.

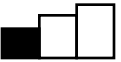
SUPPORT AUSTIN ARTISTS
