### Red River Area Improvements – Project Information



#### **HISTORY**

- Resolution No. 20170608-033 directed the City Manager to explore a variety of public infrastructure enhancements along Red River Street.
- Stakeholder engagement meetings were completed to inform design and improvements by a collaborative effort by the City of Austin's Public Works Department (PWD) and Economic Development Department (EDD)

#### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS TO DATE**

- Austin Resource Recovery (ARR) installed ten trash and recycling receptacles along Red River between 6th and 11th Streets.
- Austin Energy (AE) completed a lighting study for the district.
- The City of Austin completed installation of a gate and fence system in the alley at the 700 block of Red River Street (between 711 and 715 Street) in late 2019.
- EDD led efforts with a Public-Private Partnership to install three murals honoring the areas history and culture
- District Wayfinding signage design and location scouting completed, pending funding





#### **PROJECT TIMELINE**

### START OF CONSTRUCTION: SEPTEMBER 1ST, 2021

END OF CONSTRUCTION: APRIL 8, 2022

 Due to the restrictions on construction timing overall project may take longer with coordination of supplies and communication with businesses



#### CONSIDERATIONS

- •Project will be implemented in phases
- •Phases will be by area of the District to avoid various areas under construction
- •City of Austin and the Contractor team will work with businesses on-going when their business space may be impacted by the construction during specific phases
- •City of Austin will be diligent coordinate around large events
- •Coordination around parking related to construction and tour bus or delivery zones will occur
