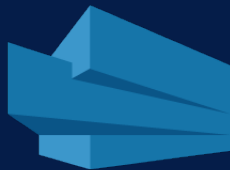

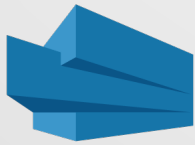

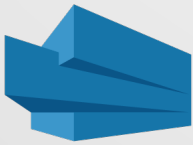

Project History

- [Resolution No. 20170608-033](#) directed the City Manager to explore a variety of public infrastructure enhancements along Red River Street.
- Stakeholder engagement meetings were completed to inform design and improvements by a collaborative effort by the City of Austin's Public Works Department (PWD) and Economic Development Department (EDD)

Projects Completed:

- Trash and recycling receptacles
- Gate and fence system at the 700 block of Red River
- Murals
- Place-based activations
- District identity neon signage
- Bike rack installations
- District wayfinding (under design)
- Tree removal and trimming

Overall Project Timeline

Start of Construction: Began Mid-December 2021

End of Construction: Summer 2022

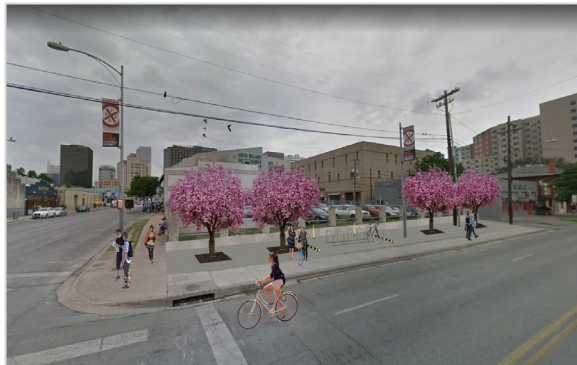
Expected Construction Hours:

- Sunday- Wednesday 7AM – 5PM
- Thursdays 7AM – 3PM
- No construction Fridays and Saturdays*
- Due to the restrictions on construction timing overall project may take longer with coordination of supplies and communication with businesses

*These proposed construction hours are subject to change

Construction hours are subject shift as we work directly with business owners at different stages of the projects

Area Improvements



- Sidewalk repairs and improvements
- Curb cuts and street alignment (9th Street)
- Pedestrian safety improvements
- Pedestrian scale solar lighting pilot
- Planters/landscaping (pending maintenance agreements)

Completed Work: 600-700 Block of Red River

- Construction began within the 600-700 Block of Red River
- Improvements Completed:
 - Pedestrian Safety Improvements SW, SE, NE Corners of 7th and Red River
 - Partial curb closure of driveways adjacent to intersections
 - Sidewalk repair and improvements
 - Bus Stop Relocation



Expected Work: Next 30 Days

- Construction of the 7th Street Plaza to begin
- Improvements Include:
 - Driveway Improvements along Northside of Plaza
 - Pedestrian Safety Improvements of NE Corner of 7th and Red River
 - Demolition of “Double Sidewalk”
 - Construction of wide Pedestrian Plaza
 - Solar Lighting Installation
- Improvement Impacts:
 - Sidewalk Closure: NW Corner of 7th and Red River; From Intersection to Alley along West Side of Red River Street
 - Potential Parking Impacts
 - Temporary Lane Closures along construction zone

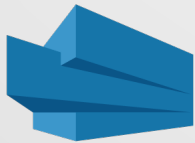
