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<b>Indicator Description</b>	The percentage of responses into the City of Austin that are performed by ambulances assigned to County EMS stations.

<b>Data Provided By</b>	Business Analysis and Research Team
<b>Reporting Values</b>	Percent of ATCEMS ambulance responses into the City of Austin performed by ambulances that are stationed in the County service area.
<b>Limitations</b>	<p>This measure is limited to incidents received through the 911 system, occurring within the ATCEMS service area. Mutual aid responses to incidents occurring outside the service area are excluded, as are responses to special events or other prescheduled standbys.</p> <p>Responses by ambulances that are not part of the ATCEMS regularly scheduled system coverage are excluded from the measure, as are responses by commanders, support staff, and other vehicles.</p>

## Measure Calculation

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<b>Formula Description</b>	Count of responses by regularly scheduled County ambulances into the City service area, divided by the count of all ambulance responses in the City service area.  The resulting measure is expressed as a percentage.
<b>Indicator Formula</b>	$Value = \frac{[count\ of\ County\ ambulance\ responses\ into\ City]}{[count\ of\ all\ responses\ into\ City]}$
<b>Data Filters</b>	Include incident response priorities 1-5  Exclude test, duplicate, StarFlight, and Special Event problem types.  Exclude incidents that fall outside of City of Austin and Travis County.  Include only responses by regularly scheduled ambulances.
<b>Interval Calculation</b>	Not applicable
<b>Numerator</b>	<p><i>Population</i> Responses by regularly scheduled County ambulances to incidents received via the 911 system that fall within the full purpose jurisdiction of the City of Austin.</p> <p><i>Inclusion</i> Includes responses terminated prior to arrival of the unit at the scene, including but not limited to those with disposition of “Cancelled” or “Reconfigured.”</p> <p><i>Exclusion</i> All responses by regularly scheduled City ambulances.  Responses by any ambulance to Special Events or other prescheduled standbys.  Responses by County ambulances to incidents occurring outside the full purpose jurisdiction of the City of Austin. <b>Denominator</b>	<p><i>Population</i> Responses by all regularly scheduled system ambulances to incidents received via the 911 system that fall within the full purpose jurisdiction of the City of Austin.</p>

**Inclusion** Includes responses terminated prior to arrival of the unit at the scene, including but not limited to those with disposition of “Cancelled” or “Reconfigured.”

**Exclusion** Responses by any ambulance to Special Events or other prescheduled standbys.

Ambulance responses to incidents occurring outside the full service jurisdiction of the City of Austin.

All responses by ambulances that are not regularly scheduled for ATCEMS system coverage.

**Aggregation** Aggregate by month based on the incident’s date/time of phone pickup in Communications.

**Stratification** None

**Data Lineage** Data for this measure is drawn from the ATCEMS CAD data warehouse. The warehouse is populated from the CTECC CAD reporting warehouse via ATCEMS-developed ETL processes.
