

Airport Expansion and Development Program

- The Airport Expansion and Development Program (AEDP) guides development and construction at AUS over the next five to seven years.
- The AEDP takes a re-strategized approach at implementing key components of the 2040 Master Plan.
 - Optimizing the Barbara Jordan Terminal (BJT)
 - Building a midfield concourse and connecting underground tunnel
 - A new Central Utility Plant & electrical substation
 - Relocating and improving taxiways

The purpose of the AEDP is to:


- Improve the passenger experience and accommodate forecasted demand








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NEPA Overview

- The EA is a review process guided by NEPA that will assess potential impacts to the environment associated with airport construction projects.
 - This review process will determine if significant impacts would occur.
 - This EA is prepared in accordance with NEPA, as amended, under Council of Environmental Quality (CEQ) Regulations for Implementing the Procedural Provisions of NEPA, FAA Order 1050.1F, Environmental Impacts: Policies and Procedures, 1050.1F Desk Reference, and FAA Order 5050.4B, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Implementing Instructions for Airport Actions, applicable Executive Orders (EOs), and other applicable federal, state, and local requirements.
