Thank you for participating in the written exam for Fire Cadet. Here's some information on what to expect next.

How to Get Your Written Exam Score

Results from the written exam will be posted on AFD's Employment website (<http://austintexas.gov/department/current-applicants>) no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 8, 2012. Please do not call or email the Austin Fire Department to obtain your written test score. You must check the website to obtain your score on the written exam; results will not be e-mailed out to applicants. Scores will be listed on the website in numerical order by Confirmation Number. Please make sure you keep your Confirmation Number so that you can obtain your score.

The primary source of the information on the hiring process and next steps will be communicated via the Internet. Please check the website (<http://austintexas.gov/department/current-applicants>) often for updates and keep your confirmation number handy.

What Happens Next?

The top 1500 applicants who pass the written exam will be invited to participate in the Structured Oral Interview (SOI), which will be held July 9-13, 2012. We are in the process of finalizing the details for the SOI and will post information on the website when available.

Specific dates for the remaining steps in the employment process are not available at this time. When information is available, it will be posted on our website. Please do not call or email AFD asking for timeline information.

The anticipated start for the next academy class is January 14, 2013.

What Can I do now to prepare?

- Click on the CPAT Preparation link on our website to access the CPAT Preparation Guide and maintain your physical conditioning.
- If you qualify for Military Bonus points (see Employment Process Summary on the website), make sure you have access to your original Form DD214-4 (member 4 form). DD214's will be required by July 6, 2012 in order to qualify for points. Check the web for details on providing your DD214.
