

Mobile Vaccination Program (MVP)

Frequently Asked Questions:

How many participants can an MVP event accommodate?

An MVP event can accommodate a maximum of 100 to 120 anticipated participants. If the estimated participant number is larger than this, we can plan for a larger event with a pop-up clinic.

For how long can an MVP event be scheduled?

Typically, the maximum number of hours the MVP schedules is 3.5 hours, but longer time periods can be accommodated. Note that this does not include time set aside for driving to and from the location and time for setup and teardown.

Can an MVP event be set up outdoors?

If a partner is looking to plan for an outdoor event, we ask that they have a plan A and plan B, to be sure that the event can go on despite inclement weather. Examples for contingency plan setups include: a classroom, a cafeteria, a gymnasium, or a pavilion.

Does a site visit need to be facilitated before an MVP event?

We do request to facilitate a site visit, if the site is new to APH.

What kind of outreach can be provided with scheduled events?

The MVP can provide a flyer for each scheduled event. Flyers should be requested at least 5 BUSINESS DAYS before an event, so that enough time can be allocated for promotion. We can also offer an outreach/educational team to assist with promoting your event.

How far in advance should an event request be submitted?

We ask for at least 1 to 2 weeks' advance notice, to ensure we have ample time to plan for the event. Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

How can a partner request an MVP event?
