Below is the link to determine “if” or “if not” a property is located within “Full Jurisdiction” City Limits of Austin.

Below are instructions how to maneuver the website:

1. Go to www.austintexas.gov/department/gis-and-maps
2. Click on “Developer Web Map”
3. Click on “Acknowledge”
4. Expand view of Map to full screen.
5. Type house number & street name, then click “Go”
6. Wait for page to completely load and display map
7. Choose “Address” under Viewer Tools on left side of screen (Blue Bar)
8. Enter Street Address, then click “Locate”
9. Wait for page to completely load and display map with a RED tack that indicates property location.
10. In the Grey box titled “Map Layers” and scroll down to “Political Boundaries”
11. Click the box next to “Jurisdiction - Austin”
12. On TOP menu bar, under the “Map Tools” button, click “Identify”
13. Click on “RED tack” on the map
14. A white box will pop up that will disclose the jurisdiction of the property.
15. The box must indicate “City of Austin and Austin Full Purpose”, for the property to be considered for City of Austin DPA.

Notes:

- All resale properties must also pass a City performed Housing Quality Standard (HQS) Inspection to be considered for City of Austin DPA.
- All newly constructed properties must meet S.M.A.R.T. standards that are set forth by the City of Austin.
- Other restrictions apply.
