I have legal documents and recordings; I also have signs posted throughout my community that says Private Property no Trespassing. I would like the same treatment each time and not different results based off race or ethnicity which is what I feel is transpiring here. I would also like to make a formal complaint with Internal Affairs because these officers are not doing their job properly and fairly. Also, on today when I was giving an example Officer Brito (8505) decided to tell me about my ID address not matching and how that was a crime, yet he can't follow basic crime 101.
