## Monument Dimensions

The following dimensions reflect the two dimensional footprint of the monument on the ground (length and width). The recommended overall height of these monuments is a maximum of 24 ", The overall height of any monument design selected shall not exceed $42^{\prime \prime}$

- A monument set over three spaces ( 42 " North to South) to commemorate three adults or juveniles can be a maximum of 40 " North to South and 12 " East to West ( 40 " $\times 12^{\prime \prime}$ ).
- A monument set over a single space ( $144^{\prime \prime}$ North to South) to commemorate one adult or juvenile can be a maximum of $12^{\prime \prime}$ North to South and 6" East to West ( $12^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ )
- A monument set over a single space ( $14^{\prime \prime}$ North to South) to commemorate two children or infants can be a maximum of 12 " North to South and 6 " East to West ( 12 " $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ ) Note: two 12 " $\times 6$ " monuments may be set over a child/infant space to individually commemorate one child or infant per monument *See Infant/Child space diagram*
- A monument set over two child/infant spaces ( $28^{\prime \prime N o r t h ~ t o ~ S o u t h) ~ t o ~ c o m m e m o r a t e ~ f o u r ~}$ children or infants can be a maximum of $24^{\prime \prime}$ North to South and 12 " East to West.
