DRAWING

Drawing 101 **Instructor: David Thornberry**

Wednesday \$124 / 5 classes 6 PM – 9 PM 10/30 – 12/4 No class: 11/27

This class is designed both for the non-artist with just a desire to create or for the experienced person that would like to sharpen their skills. The goal of this class is to cover the absolute essentials such as composition, getting line under control, how to start a drawing and perspective. The course is very hands-on and we will be working from observed still life set-ups. You can overcome those barriers and intimidations that are holding you back. You can learn to draw! Class held in 8E. Limit 12 students.

PAINTING

Beginning Acrylic Painting **Instructor: David Thornberry**

Develop creative and aesthetic sensibilities through the expressive art of painting. Learn basic painting techniques and concepts such as color theory, composition, value and brush techniques. This class is very hands-on and we will be working from observed still life set-ups. The goal is to overcome those barriers and intimidations that are holding you back. This class is for the absolute beginner or students interested in furthering their skills. Class held in 8E. Limit 12 students.

Modernizing the Landscape **Instructor: Nancy Michalewicz**

Transform the natural landscape by simplifying shapes into color fields, texture, and focal points. The goal of this class is to help you edit visual elements and diminishing details, you will have new meaning in a landscape painting and will intentionally depart from complete representation. Feel free to explore with either oil or acrylic paint in this fun-filled class. All landscape work is done in the classroom using photography and other inspiration. This class is appropriate for intermediate painters who have a good feel for basic techniques in painting. Class held in 8E. Limit 12 students.

This is a mixed media class where you are free to explore with a variety of mixed mediums such as charcoal, pastel, watercolor and mixed media.
