La Ausente - A man suffers great pain for the death of his wife in an automobile accident and decides to investigate the surroundings of the accident that he thinks are mysterious. Directed by Arturo Martínez, 1972. Spanish w/ English Subtitles, 100 min.

Distinto Amanecer - A union leader is killed on the orders of a corrupt governor and his partner looks for documents that compromise the murderer. Directed by Julio Bracho, 1943. Spanish, 108 min.

La Perla - A family has just taken possession of a pearl that is worth thousands and others try to get in on the cash. their only hope is to leave the village, but on their journey is fraught with peril. Directed by Emilio Fernández, 1947. Spanish, 85 min.
