- Want cooler swings
- More benches for seating

What is the most popular / least popular play feature?

- The closer to the pavilion, the less the equipment is used because there are typically people living in the pavilion
- Don't like the mulch
 - Children throw the mulch at each other
 - Floods
 - Not accessible
 - Needles in mulch
- Don't want sand
- Popular features (and proposed features):
 - Swings
 - Monkey bars
 - Climbing features
 - Spinning wheel
 - Mini-rockwall
 - Rubber surfacing
 - Musical feature
