






History of Givens Pool

- The 41-acre park includes the Aquatic Facility, Recreation Center, Sport Courts, Athletic Fields and Pavilions.
- The park and pool are named after Dr. Everett H. Givens, a community leader and dentist.
- The pool first opened in 1958.
- In 2018, voters approved a General Obligation Bond for design and construction of a new aquatic facility.






WHAT IS BUILT WITH THE POOL?



- Ash Tree (middle on north side) has died and will be removed


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Givens Pool Concept

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
