

COUNCIL RESOLUTION

In June 2022, Resolution 20220609-123 directed the City Manager to include an appropriation of \$700,00 in the 2022-23 budget to fund placemaking projects in the Rainey Historic District.

64 RAINEY STREET



PARAMETERS:

- Approximately 6000 square feet
- All permit and right of way fees for new construction benefit the Rainey Historic District (not just 64 Rainey)
- PARD no longer designs water features because of long-term drought
- Funding is inadequate to support a building
- Investing in 64 Rainey will give us access to AIPP funding right now
- Alley property is still not ours; requires Council action
