

OBSERVED HOLIDAYS – NO RESERVATION PERIODS:

On a limited number of Federal <u>Holidays</u>, <u>Observances</u> and other dates, the Parks and Recreation Department does not coordinate reservations for picnic sites or facilities due to the high volume of public use. During peak event seasons, the department may also limit the number of reservations in an area in order to maintain public access to park in a concentrated area, or balance access within a specific park. **On these dates, all picnic sites are** <u>first-come first-served for shared picnic use</u>. **Facilities are NOT regularly reserved on these days**.

ALERT: On holiday weekends, <u>**PERMITS CANNOT BE ISSUED</u></u> for moonwalks/rockwalls, or amplified sound (dj's, bands, stereos).</u>**
