PERMITS –Available to Confirmed Reservations Availability Varies by Picnic Site

Sound Permit \$20/permit

- If permitted, amplified sound at picnic sites should be contained and enjoyed by ONLY those at the picnic site area. No amplified sound from cars permitted.
- Larger rental equipment set ups, live performances, multi-piece bands or stacked equipment is impactful and is permitted at special event venues and event facilities. Extensive sound equipment is typically NOT permitted and accommodated at picnic sites due to proximity to other park users, playscapes or residential uses.

Alcohol Permit Approval must be granted during the booking process. NO Sales allowed without additional approvals.

Moonwalk, Inflatables, and Rock Wall Permits: Prohibited at picnic rentals. Reviewed and permitted at large special events.
