Submit a Proposal

Review FAQ section on CAPP Webpage and submit a proposal online to the Parks and Recreation Department (PARD).

Stage 2 Internal Review

Survey by PARD and other relevant agencies (e.g. Public Works, Watershed Protection).

Review of city code for site constraints and considerations.



Site Visit

PARD staff coordinates site visit.

Discussion of proposal feasibility,
maintenance implications, and how
project meets community and city goals.

Determine next steps.

Project Development

PARD assigns a project manager to support as proposer gathers community feedback, seeks funding, defines maintenance roles & responsibilities, and finalizes design.





Implementation

Once funding is secured, PARD supports implementation and proposer submits wrap-up report.
